## From the Desk of Fr. Bart

### Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time and Our Parish's Patronal Feast Day



This weekend we have substituted the regular Sunday Readings for the Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time with the Readings from the Memorial Mass of St. Thomas Aquinas. The theme of our Gospel (Mark 4:35-41) is "Faith." This is a good time as a parish family to reflect upon and measure the strength of our faith.

As the Venerable Archbishop Fulton Sheen once said, "There are not even 100 people in this country who hate the Catholic Church, but there are millions who hate what they think the Catholic Church to be." In fact, we have a beautiful faith. There is so much joy and beauty in the beliefs and teachings of the Catholic Church. In the Church today, one can experience the most personal relationship with Christ through the Holy Eucharist, the gift of Christ's Body and Blood to us. For centuries, the Catholic Church has been the place to turn to for the source of Christian belief, an intimate encounter with Jesus Christ, a welcoming family, and a guiding light to get to heaven.

G.K. Chesterton once wrote, "The difficulty in explaining 'why I am a Catholic' is that there are ten thousand reasons all amounting to one reason: that Catholicism is true." The Catholic Church is not just one denomination among many. In fact, it can trace its founding roots back to Jesus Christ, who started our Church. For 2,000 years the Catholic Church has guarded the truth that Jesus has taught, whether in or out of style. Though it's not perfect, nor does it have perfect members, the Church still contains the fullness of truth, which Jesus promised would set us free.

Since its founding, the Catholic Church has continued to be the largest body of Christians on earth. The word "Catholic" means universal, and that is really what the Catholic Church is—a universal body of believers, united in Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. Our Catholic family is made up of people from every race, age, and walk of life.

Among them is the strong patron of our parish, Saint Thomas Aquinas, who inspires us to devote our lives to Jesus Christ. We also have a special gift of one another in those who make up this unique, loving family of disciples. Catholic author Mathew Kelly points out:

The people we surround ourselves with either raise or lower our standards.

They either help us to become the-best-version-of-ourselves or encourage us to become lesser versions of ourselves. We become like our friends.

No man becomes great on his own. No woman becomes great on her own. The people around them help to make them great.

We all need people in our lives who raise our standards, remind us of our essential purpose, and challenge us to become the-best-version-of-ourselves.

Today we thank God for the gift of our Catholic faith and our St. Thomas Aquinas Parish Family. We are blessed to be a part of this faith community that helps us to love Jesus and become the best version of ourselves that we can be. St. Thomas Aquinas, pray for us!

## Reflection from Our Parish Seminarian, Lawrence Oparaji

What kind of soil are our hearts? Do they give Jesus' love no chance to grow, because we feel too broken to be loved and too sinful to be

redeemed? Or do our hearts give Jesus' love a chance by totally surrendering to Him and allowing Him to love us, because we know that He alone can fix our brokenness and lead us to a place of rest, peace, and hope? God is constantly looking for ways to give to us but are we open and willing to receive? Just as a full box leaves no space for any new additions, so also our hearts leave no room for God to fill us with his love, mercy, compassion, and infinite goodness when they are full of our own desires and cling to our own ways.

Today we celebrate our patron saint, the patron of this beautiful parish family, St. Thomas Aquinas. He is often called the "angelic doctor" because of his life of piety and his bright mind, which has contributed a great deal to our Christian faith and how we explain it. How was he able to do all these things? Simple! He made himself fertile soil; he approached the Lord in humble prayer acknowledging his sinfulness and brokenness and his need for redemption and fixing. By so doing he was able to be used as God's instrument, not only for his own redemption but for others too. I know a lot of people who say reading St. Thomas Aquinas is the reason they are Catholics today.

Our humanity is constantly searching for the infinite and our modern mistake is thinking that something outside of us will fill this desire. We need to surrender our search to God and ask Him to use us, just as He used St. Thomas Aquinas, so that we may be His instruments. In this way we may be truly free and our search for the infinite will be complete by finding Him who is infinite love, infinite goodness and infinite mercy.


## Edgewood Campus School Open House


