## From the Desk of Fr. Bart

### The Nativity of St. John the Baptist

On June 24th every year, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Nativity of John the Baptist. This is a rare event in the liturgical calendar of the church. There are only two other times we celebrate a nativity in the church's calendar year. Everyone knows that we celebrate Jesus's birth at Christmas, but we also celebrate the Virgin Mary's birth on September 8 every year too. It is also rare that June 24 falls on a Sunday.



Today's feast, the feast of the Visitation, and several other feasts highlight Christ's personal family, and in emphasizing his family relationship, help us celebrate our own families. I grew up in a small town surrounded by cousins and relatives. I have 70 first cousins and we all grew up near each other, attended school together, and our families did many things together. My cousins were also my friends!

Having enjoyed such a blessing of cousins, I remember thinking about the Blessed Virgin Mary and her cousin St. Elizabeth and their close relationship. I thought about Mary's love for her cousin that made her immediately travel by foot to help, even though Mary herself was pregnant. That special love for her cousin speaks volumes to me. I am sure Jesus and John the Baptist must have visited each other and played together as children, because Mary and Elizabeth had a close friendship and love and would have tried to visit each other. And when the mothers visit, of course the children have to tag along! Now it is my nieces' and nephews' turn to relish the relationship with their cousins. I really enjoy watching them enjoy each other's company and seeing the older ones taking care of the younger ones. We are all anxiously awaiting the newest addition who will be born in July. This will be my parents' eighth grandchild.

We can consider the Nativity of St. John the Baptist as "Cousins' Day!" In this modern era where the family seems to be breaking apart in so many ways, the Church's Liturgy provides examples of true, loving family relationships, not just of husband and wife and children, but the extended family of aunts, uncles, cousins and grandparents. Nurturing family relationships, especially with cousins, is one way to celebrate the Birth of John the Baptist.

### 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Blessed Paul VI's Encyclical: *Humanae Vitae*

#### What the Church Teaches:

#### "God's Vision of Married Love and the Gift of Life"

In *Humanae Vitae* Blessed Pope Paul VI reflects upon how God designed the nature of married love. This he draws from Sacred Scripture and the Catholic Tradition. The Holy Father writes that married love is fully human (involving the body and soul). Married love is total, faithful, and fruitful (see HV no. 9). "Fruitfulness" is discussed primarily in terms of God's gift of fertility to husband and wife. So important is this gift that Scripture teaches that God calls husband and wife to take up a sacred stewardship over the powers of life that He shares with them (see Gen. 1:26-28; cf. HV, no. 8). Indeed, this gift is directly related to how God created men and women in the divine image (made for communion with God and each other--life-giving love). Children are gifts from God. They are part of the fabric of married love. Consequently, spouses should be open to receiving children lovingly seeking to nurture them as they form their families. Procreation and care of children go hand in hand!

*Humanae Vitae* raises up the question of planning births in a family. The Church has always taught that it is reasonable for husband and wife to space and even limit births in their marriage for just reasons

## Reflection from Our Seminarian, Deacon Lawrence Oparaji



At Christmas we celebrated the divine conception and birth of the divine person, Jesus Christ; today is “Baptistmas,” the celebration of the human conception and birth of John the Baptist, the greatest human person among those born of women.

The parallels between the conception, birth, life, and death of John and Jesus are many and instructive. Both births were foreshadowed by announcements by the same archangel Gabriel; first to an elderly barren woman named Elizabeth, the mother of John the Baptist, the second to a young virgin named Mary, the mother of Jesus Christ. The angel's first message was doubted and John's father Zechariah was struck dumb, but Mary believed the angel's message and she rejoiced singing the *Magnificat*. John the Baptist was filled by the Holy Spirit after his conception in Elizabeth's womb; Jesus was conceived in Mary's womb by the Holy Spirit. Both women were known to each other; they were cousins. The names of their sons were both divine names suggested by the archangel Gabriel. The birth of John the Baptist ushered in the dawn of salvation, while the birth of Jesus Christ was the dawn of salvation itself. The death of John the Baptist initiated Christ's proclamation of the Kingdom of heaven; the death of Jesus Christ opened up for us the Kingdom of heaven.

As John the Baptist, the greatest of all the prophets, announced the first coming of the Messiah and by his witness called the people to repentance for the sake of the imminent coming Kingdom of Heaven, so too the prophetic life of every Christian, received at our baptism, is supposed to be a forerunner to the second coming of Christ and witness to the Kingdom of Heaven before the world. The virtues of John the Baptist are instructive to us in this light: his humble acknowledgment of his littleness before the Christ; his will to decrease self that Christ may increase; his faithfulness to his vocation; his austere life of mind and body discipline for the sake of the spirit, the courage with which he stood up for the truth, even before King Herod.

As we celebrate John the Baptist today let us ask for a renewed vigor for evangelization. Let us ask for the grace to bear witness to the goodness of God in our lives, for the grace to proclaim the greatness of God to all His creation.

(see HV, no. 10); however, they are called to *support* God's design not to reject it. Use of contraception or sterilization rejects God's gifts. That is because contraception and sterilization do harm to the nature of married love and the gift of life—they separate the unitive and procreative nature of conjugal relations (see HV, no. 14). Saying this another way, "husband and wife express their committed love not only with words, but with the language of their bodies ....the mutual gift of fertility is an integral part of the bonding power of marital intercourse." (USCCB, *Married Love and the Gift of Life*, pp. 4, 5.) To reject one's fertility by using contraception or being sterilized is to reject God's gift to husband and wife (see HV, no. 12).

*Does this mean that couples are to leave their family size to chance? No!*

God invites husband and wife to cooperate with Him in their mission of responsible parenthood. Spouses should pay careful attention to the nature of marriage as God created it, their current responsibilities to each other, any children already born, and the wider society (see HV no. 10). Within this context, the methods of **Natural Family Planning** (NFP) are acceptable because they respect God's divine plan for marriage!
