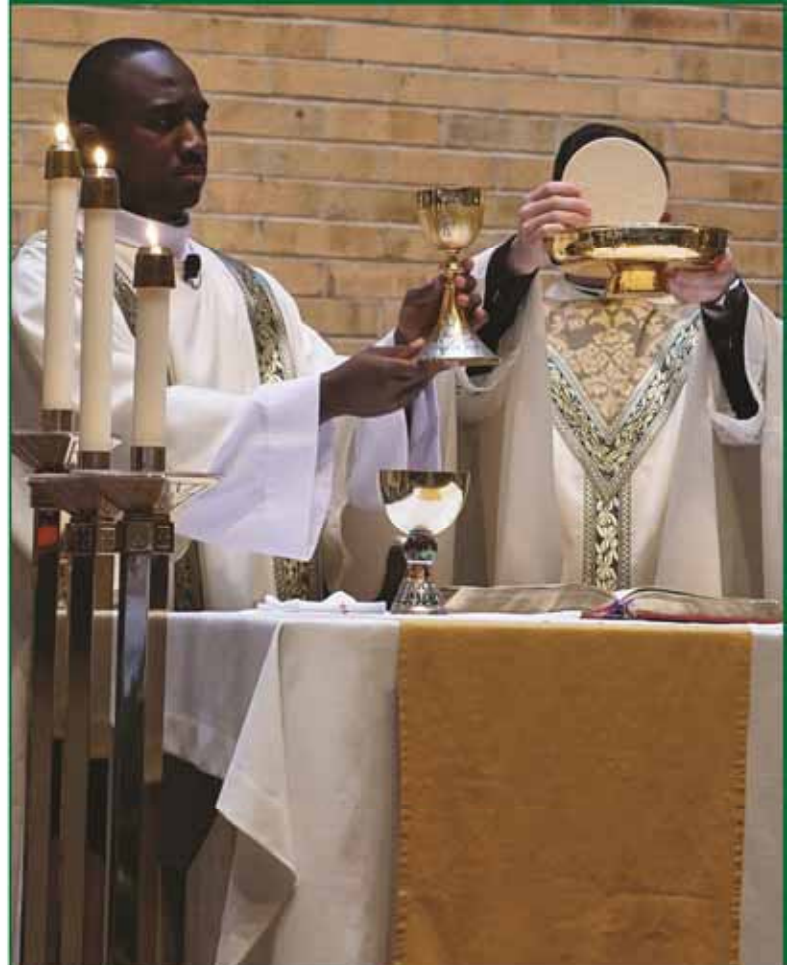

From the Desk of Fr. Bart

Solemnity of The Most Sacred Body and Blood of Christ- Corpus Christi

The Feast of the Sacred Body and Blood of Jesus reminds us that Christ still gives Himself to us in the Most Holy Eucharist. It is a profound, prophetic and powerful Feast in the liturgical year of our Catholic Church. When it is celebrated, it is meant to be a richly significant day in Catholic Christian life. In our Holy Communion we receive the Body of Christ! Let us choose to become what we consume. Today's Solemnity is not just a ritual on a Church calendar. It is an invitation to encounter the Lord Jesus Christ, and then offer Him to a world waiting to be born anew. On this Feast of Corpus Christi, let us ask the Lord to come and take up residence within us anew. Let us receive, adore and become Eucharist for others.

In 1264 Pope Urban IV asked St. Thomas Aquinas, our Patron Saint, to compose two Offices of Prayer. He did so, along with five hymns, and they have nourished the piety of Christians for centuries. In one of them St. Thomas noted:

“Material food first of all turns itself into the person who eats it, and as a consequence, restores his losses and increases his vital energies. Spiritual food, on the other hand, turns the person who eats it into Itself. Thus, the proper effect of this sacrament is the conversion of man into Christ, so that he may no longer live for himself, but that Christ may live in him. And as a consequence it has the double effect of restoring the spiritual losses caused by sins and defects and of increasing the power of the virtues.”

On this Feast we proclaim our belief in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. We also proclaim that same Jesus lives within each one of us who are baptized into His Body, the Church, of which we are members. That is also a Real presence. He comes to dwell within us - and we live our lives now in Him. We are invited to become a living monstrance, carrying the Lord within us, showing Him forth to the world, in word and action.

Reflection from Our Seminarian, Deacon Lawrence Oparaji



Today we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi (Latin for “Body of Christ”), the Solemnity of the most precious Body and Blood of Christ, our spiritual food and drink. Today we celebrate food, and the kind of food that gives life to the soul and sustains it. The kind of food Christ was talking about when he said, “unless you eat my flesh and drink my blood you will have no life in you.”


The Eucharist is food for the soul. Just as the body cannot live without natural food and drink, the soul is weakened when it is apart from the Eucharistic Body and Blood of our Lord. The Eucharist feeds and nourishes the soul enabling it to carry out good and virtuous deeds as well as live the universal call to holiness. The moral life, the call to holiness, and the spiritual life is tough if you have not noticed this already. Research has shown a large number of people, especially young people, falling away from the faith due to resentment for the moral life, call to holiness, and spiritual life. And believe me, I understand the difficult nature of what we are called to in this life as followers of Jesus, but I also know that there is help. This help is what we call “grace” in Christian theology, in fact plenty of help is to be found on the altar, in the Eucharist that feeds our soul and strengthens our resolve to always choose the good, to use our freedom to choose the things of God.

Where do I start from and how do I even begin to thank you all for your prayers, love and support that have brought me this far and continues to spur me on? This past weekend has been a blessing to me, a blessing not only because I was ordained to the Sacred Order of the Diaconate, but because of the love and support I have received from all of you. 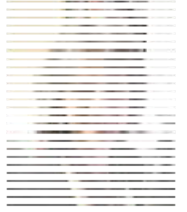

There are many opportunities for our parishioners to become active in our music ministry here at St. Thomas Aquinas. Our formal choirs are off for the summer months, but will begin rehearsals again in September. Our Choristers rehearse on Wednesdays during the school year and sing on Saturdays at 4:30 PM and Sundays at 10:00 AM. This group is open to students in grades 4 and up! Adults and students are also encouraged to join our small groups which sing at our Masses throughout the year, primarily on Saturdays at 4:30 PM and Sundays at 8:00 AM, but also during the summer months at 10:00 AM. Our STA Spanish Choir rehearses on Sundays at 5:00 PM and sings weekly for the 6:30 PM Spanish Mass. There are other opportunities to become involved as well, based upon age and ability.
