40 Days for Life

40 Days for Life is a community-based campaign to end abortion that takes a determined, peaceful approach to showing local communities the consequences of abortion in their own neighborhoods, for their own friends and families. It puts into action a desire to cooperate with God in the carrying out of His plan for the end of abortion. It draws attention to the evil of abortion through the use of a three-point program: Prayer and fasting; Constant vigil, Community outreach.

The visible, public centerpiece of *40 Days for Life* is a focused, 40-day, non-stop, round-the-clock prayer vigil outside the Planned Parenthood Abortion Center in our community.

It is a peaceful and educational presence. Those who are called to stand witness during this 24-hour-a-day presence send a powerful message to the community about the tragic reality of abortion. Our Parish Respect Life Committee has committed to two hours each week during the 40 days on Thursdays from 5PM-7PM. I will be at the Planned Parenthood Abortion Center on **Thursday, September 27 at 6PM** to lead prayers for an end to abortion. I invite you to please join me in this important effort on behalf of the unborn. Sign-up sheets are in the Gathering Area for us you to sign up for a time to pray and give witness.

Mass Intention Scheduling for 2019

Mass Intentions for 2019 will be scheduled starting **Monday, October 1**. **Each registered household may schedule 3 Masses in 2019 for existing intentions.** You can schedule Masses by phone, email, or in person at the parish office by the Gathering Area. The stipend is \$10 per Mass, payable in cash or by check payable to St. Thomas Aquinas.

Because so many people can only attend Mass on the weekend, **each registered household is limited to one Mass on a weekend (Saturday or Sunday)** so that these available to as many families as possible. This limit does not apply to new needs that arise during the year.

Other guidelines:

- One Mass each week will be left unscheduled until the preceding week to handle last-minute parish needs.
- Canon law requires us to offer one Mass each Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation for St. Thomas Aquinas Parishioners. These are **not** unscheduled Masses.

People who are not registered with the parish may request one Mass Intention starting January 1, 2019, subject to the availability of unscheduled dates.

Reflection from Deacon Lawrence Oparaji



Today Jesus wants to give each of us a lesson on what true greatness means: Greatness in the eyes of God is measured by humility and service to others. For the people of Jesus's time this was unconventional. Being great had nothing to do with being humble; humility was a sign of being weak, but again, Jesus Christ was never a conventional man. He ate with sinners and tax collectors. He allowed women to be part of His inner circle. He healed on the Sabbath. And He did many other unconventional things. Today He is doing something unconventional again! Jesus is giving us humility as a virtue, humility and sacrifice as the true meaning of greatness.

Jesus also presents us with a child. He uses the image of a child to teach us two things:

The first thing is to show us what our attitude should be towards God. Children are known for their openness and unwavering trust. Every child grows up absorbing the ways of the parents. Little children have an absolute trust and faith in their parents. Also, when a child is taken to a new place, the child quickly embraces the new language and culture, unlike the adult who struggles and stumbles for a long time. This openness and trust are what Christ requires from us. Jesus wants us to come to Him with a childlike trust and openness. That way we become more and more like Him, and that is the path to true greatness, because to be great is to be like Christ and to be like Christ is to be humble.

Secondly, Jesus uses the child to teach us what our attitude should be towards the people we come in contact with. The child represents the weak and vulnerable, the poor and helpless. Today Jesus is saying to us that to welcome them is to welcome Him. Jesus uses the image of a child to show us how much He desires that we, as Christians, be willing to welcome and minister to the weak and vulnerable, the poor and the helpless around us. Jesus equates Himself with those who are weak, needy, and poor because He knows that they are the ones who are the most vulnerable and the most in need, and He wants to meet them in their poverty. As Christians we are called to do the same, to minister and be present to those who are poor. And I do not mean just material poverty, but also spiritual poverty. This is the way of true greatness.
