From the Desk of Fr. Bart

Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time

It is often difficult to see something or someone that we know well with fresh eyes. Jesus returns to his hometown and the people there see him as they always have, as the son of Joseph the carpenter. Jesus tells them, "No prophet is accepted in his own native place." Prophets, by their very nature, are called to shake people out of their complacency and to point out when something new is happening. Like the people of Nazareth, we might feel like we know Jesus. As Christians we must continually strive to be open to the words of Jesus, the prophet, who would like to show us something new.

Feast of the Presentation of the Lord

On Saturday, February 2, we celebrate the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple. According to Jewish tradition, the firstborn male child belonged to God, and the parents had to "buy him back" on the 40th day after his birth, by offering a sacrifice of "a pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons (See Luke 2:24)." The Feast of the Presentation commemorates Mary's and Joseph's fulfillment of this law.

By the 11th Century, the custom had developed in the Church of blessing candles on the Feast of the Presentation inspired by the words of Simeon at Jesus' presentation: "A light to the revelation of the Gentiles." Because of this custom, the feast also became known as Candlemas. Feast of St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr

On Sunday, February 3, we celebrate the feast of St. Blaise. We will commemorate St. Blaise's Feast day after our weekend Masses this weekend with a communal blessing of throats. This is a change from the recent past where we were able to have individual blessing of throats. However, due to the shortage of available priests, we will offer a communal blessing at the end of each Mass. St. Blaise was a physician who later in life was ordained to the priesthood and eventually was made Bishop of Sebaste in Armenia. When the persecution of Christians began, he took refuge in the hills. He was discovered living in a cave, by men who had been sent to hunt him down under an order of the governor. While in prison awaiting trial and torture, Blaise performed a miraculous cure of a young boy who was choking to death on a fish bone. In gratitude, the boy's mother brought Blaise candles and food while he was imprisoned. It is because of the miraculous healing of the little boy that devotions to St. Blaise for healing of throat ailments grew through the centuries and are still performed today.

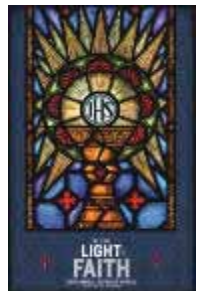

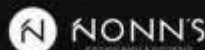
