From the Desk of Fr. Bart

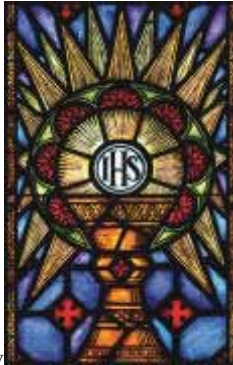
Seventh Sunday of Ordinary Time

Today Jesus tells us in the Gospel to “love our enemies.” God does not love only those who are worthy or good. God loves simply because of their very existence. And so we are also called to love as well. Our enemies could be one specific person with whom we have a feud, or it could be a group of people that we see (even if it is subconsciously) as “other” than ourselves and therefore not worthy of our concern. No matter how we might encounter “enemies” Jesus’ command remains the same, love them with the mercy, forgiveness, and compassion of God. How does your family follow Jesus’ command to “love your enemies?”



Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) 2019

This year, the total goal for our Diocese’s Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) is \$3.5 Million. Our STA 2019 ACA Parish Goal is \$107,233. This is an increase \$11,268 (12%) over last year’s goal of \$95,965. Last year 436 households out of our 1,500 households participated to raise \$125,144. My hope is that we can increase the number of households who participate so that we can accomplish our goal in support of the inspiring and important ministries of the Diocese of Madison that bring the corporal and spiritual works of mercy to those in need. Also, it is the responsibility of every household to offer our financial support to the work and ministries of our Diocese.



This past year, our parish did receive a grant from the diocese to assist us with our Hispanic Ministry to encourage youth participation in retreats and adult participation in educational programs. Besides this grant, we also have received support from many of the Diocesan Offices including the Marriage Tribunal, Family Ministries, Office of Stewardship, and the Office of Worship, just to name a few.

In addition to this direct support to our parish through Parish Services, the Annual Appeal also funds Catholic Charities, the Catholic Multi-Cultural Center, Camp Gray, Support for Catholic Schools, Hispanic and Migrant Ministry, and Continuing Education and support for Clergy.

Next weekend on March 2 and 3, we will participate in the in-pew pledge process for the Appeal. Thank you for your generous support of this important annual appeal!

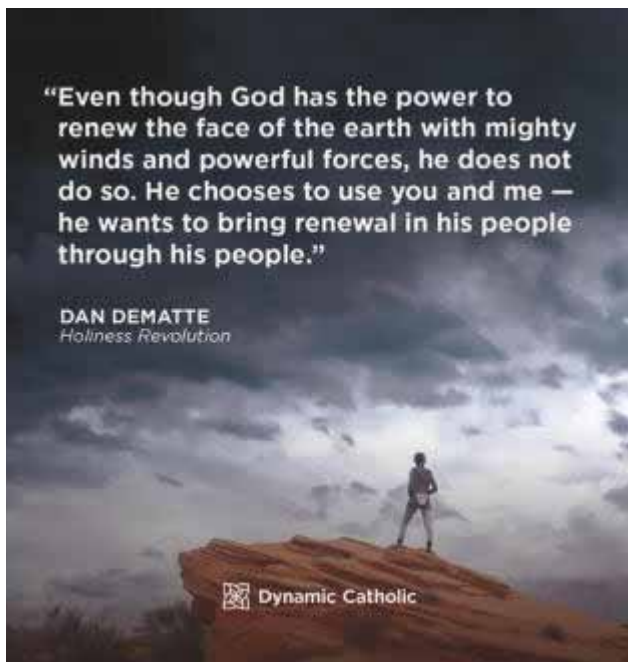
Are you looking for a “good read?” You can find one in our STA Library!

Ash Wednesday is Wednesday, March 6

Please prepare for a holy Lent by planning to join us for one of our Masses on Ash Wednesday, March 6. Mass times are: 8:30 AM, 12:15 PM, and 6:30 PM.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For Catholics, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Now would also be a good time to consider what spiritual exercises you would like to observe during Lent to help you to grow in your faith.

- Community Housing Programs such as Pregnancy Helpline, Koats for Kids, Rachel's Vineyard, and Elementary Schools to name a few.

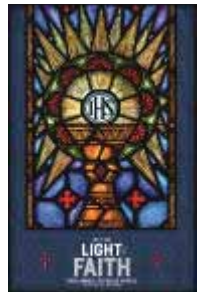
2019 Diocese of Madison Annual Catholic Appeal

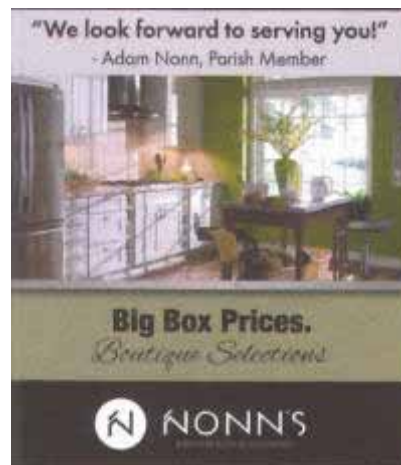

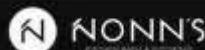
