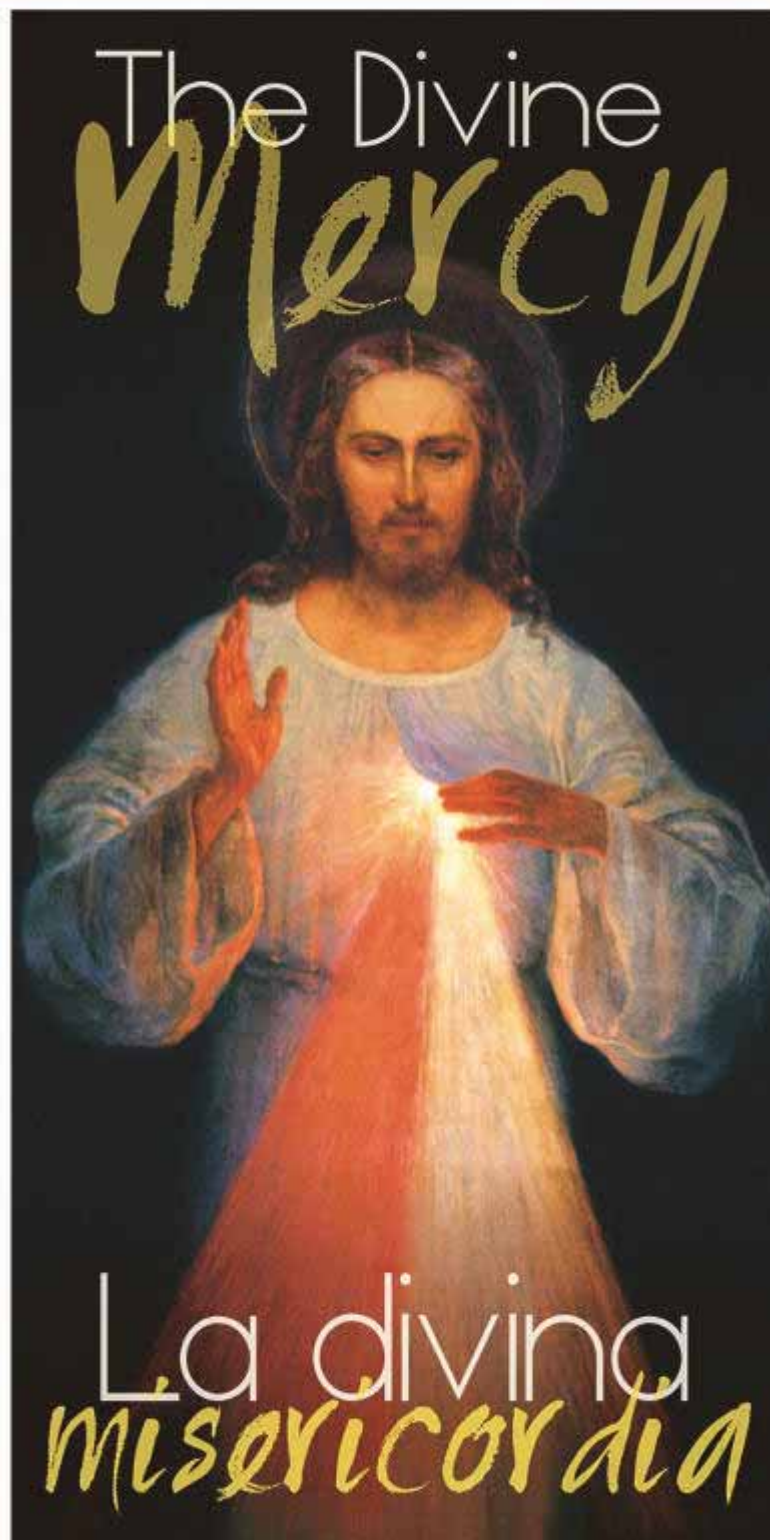

Each evening begins in the Church with Praise and Worship music at 6:30 PM and Deacon Keith will share with us his inspiring message of living out our faith in Jesus at 7:00 PM. The evenings conclude with snacks and fellowship in the Gathering Area. Deacon Keith is humorous and energetic, and has a heart for Jesus. He has an amazing charism for praying and speaking the message of Jesus, in a relatable and powerful way. Four staff members and I have heard Deacon Keith speak and find him inspirational; we are excited to offer you this special opportunity to hear him as well. I warmly invite you to attend this event, it will be a great help to you in living wholeheartedly for Jesus Christ. Please invite your family, friends, and neighbors to attend with you. Even if you cannot make it to all three nights, any evening that you attend will be a powerful experience for you.

### Divine Mercy Sunday, the Second Sunday of Easter

The essential celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday consists in the celebration of the liturgy of the Second Sunday of Easter. The scriptural readings and liturgical prayers are all centered on the forgiveness of sins and God's infinite mercy, which endures forever. In addition, it is necessary that the day publicly be called by its proper name, "Divine Mercy Sunday." Pope St. John Paul II in his 2000 public announcement during the homily for St. Faustina's canonization, stated: "It is important then that we accept the whole message that comes to us from the word of God on this Second Sunday of Easter, *which from now on throughout the Church will be called 'Divine Mercy Sunday.'*"

Pope St. John Paul II said that the image of Divine Mercy, which we display in our Sanctuary today and in our Prayer Chapel all other days, portrays the Risen Jesus Christ bringing Mercy to the whole world. Our Lord said to St. Faustina: "I want the image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it. I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish" (Diary 341, 48). Please take the time to visit with this Image of The Divine Mercy and venerate Jesus.

Jesus told St. Faustina in a private apparition that this Feast of Mercy would be a special day when "all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened" (Diary 699). Jesus promised that "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (Diary 699), and also "I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy" (Diary 1109).

This *plenary indulgence* (the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment due to sin) is granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff) to the faithful who, on the Second Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the *Our Father* and the *Creed*, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. *Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!*). Confession may be up to about 20 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday to receive this plenary indulgence.

All are welcome to pray the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy here at STA on Wednesday mornings after daily Mass (about 9:00 AM) in the Prayer

## Reflection from Seminarian Dcn. Lawrence Oparaji



During Holy week I went to Colectivo in downtown Madison to grab coffee with some seminarian brothers and on our way back to the cathedral parish we met a young man and woman. The young man asked me if I thought God could ever forgive him for all he has done; he felt he was going to hell, and there was no two ways about it. So in that moment, I asked myself what would Christ say to him, and the first word that jumped out of my mouth was “mercy.” I said to him no matter what you’ve done and where you’ve been, just remember our God is a merciful God. We ended up having a meaningful conversation and left on very pleasant terms.

Our Christian faith is all about the infinite mercy of God, without which we are lost and hopeless. No matter the situation, God’s mercy is always greater than our sins and, as St Paul sees it, “where sin increased, grace increased all the more.” The Feast of Divine Mercy validates this statement. In one of St. Faustina’s visions, Jesus said: “I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of my tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of my mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.” In today’s Gospel, Jesus institutes the Sacrament of Reconciliation as he says to his Apostles: “If you forgive anyone’s sins, they are forgiven; if you retain anyone’s sins, they are retained”. Reconciliation unleashes the ocean of God’s mercy to overrun our iniquities and cleanse us of guilt and shame.

So, let us approach God’s throne of mercy and receive the forgiveness and healing that we so long for and let us in turn remember to show mercy, love and forgiveness to others who have hurt us. God’s mercy is a two-way street, you receive it but you are also bound to show it and give it to others.

On a side note, it was tough saying good bye to everyone last weekend, but your love and support have helped me heal quickly and deeply during these times. Thanks to you all, I have come to acceptance and moving on. Please come by Sun Prairie anytime to visit; I would love to stay in touch.

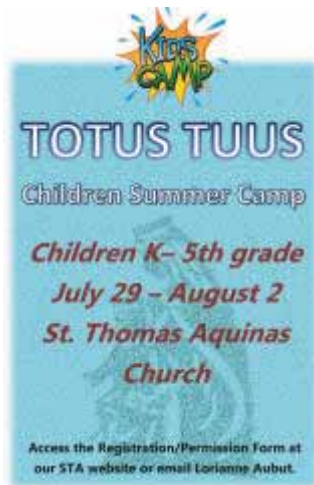

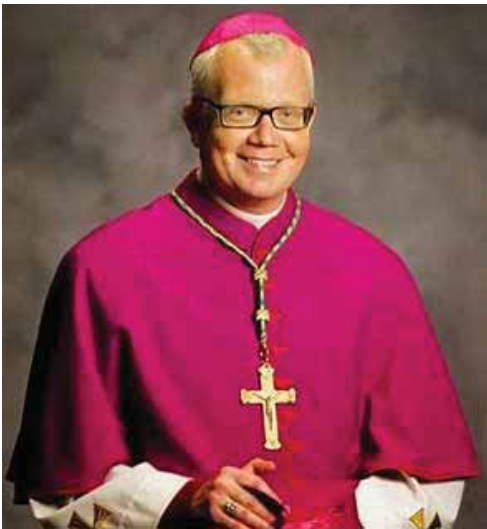

## Message from Msgr. Jim Bartylla, Diocesan Administrator of the Diocese of Madison



Dear Faithful of the Diocese of Madison:

***Annuntio Vobis Gaudium Magnum – I bring you news of great joy!* It is with honor and great pleasure that I, currently the Diocesan Administrator of the Diocese of Madison, announce that His Holiness, Pope Francis, has appointed Most Reverend Donald J. Hying, the Fifth Bishop of Madison.**

The youngest of six sons, Bishop Donald J. Hying was born in West Allis, Wisconsin. Bishop Hying received his bachelor's degree from Marquette University and his master's degree from St. Francis Seminary. On May 20, 1989, Bishop Hying was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. His first priestly assignment was as a parochial vicar for St. Anthony Parish, Menomonee Falls, from 1989 to 1994. Fr. Hying served as a Team Member for La Sagrada Familia Parroquia, Dominican Republic from 1994 to 1997. He returned to the United States and served as the parochial administrator of St. Peter Parish (1998), then as the parochial vicar of St. Anthony Parish, Milwaukee, from 1998 to 1999. He was then appointed the pastor of Our Lady of Good Hope Parish, Milwaukee from 1999 to 2005. In 2006, Fr. Hying served as the parochial administrator of St. Augustine Parish, Milwaukee in 2006. He became the Dean of Formation at Saint Francis de Sales Seminary from 2005 to 2007, and was appointed the rector of St. Francis de Sales Seminary by Most Reverend Timothy Michael Dolan, Archbishop of Milwaukee, and served from 2007 until 2011.

On May 26, 2011, Pope Benedict XVI appointed Fr. Donald Hying the Titular Bishop of Regiae and the Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. He was consecrated a bishop on July 20, 2011. On November 24, 2014, His Holiness, Pope Francis appointed Bishop Hying as the Fourth Bishop of Gary (Indiana), to succeed Most Reverend Dale Joseph Melczek, who had submitted his resignation as the Bishop of Gary, as required when he reached the age of 75. Bishop Hying's installation in the Diocese of Gary took place on January 6, 2015. On April 25, 2019, Thursday within the Octave of Easter, His Holiness, Pope Francis, appointed Most Reverend Donald J. Hying the Fifth Bishop of Madison (Wisconsin), to succeed Most Reverend Robert C. Morlino, deceased, of happy memory.

### **4. The Apostle's Creed**

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

### **5. The Eternal Father**

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

### **6. On the Ten Small Beads of Each Decade**

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

### **7. Repeat for the remaining decades**

Saying the "Eternal Father" (6) on the "Our Father" bead and then 10 "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion" (7) on the following "Hail Mary" beads.

### **8. Conclude with Holy God (Repeat three times)**

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

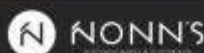
