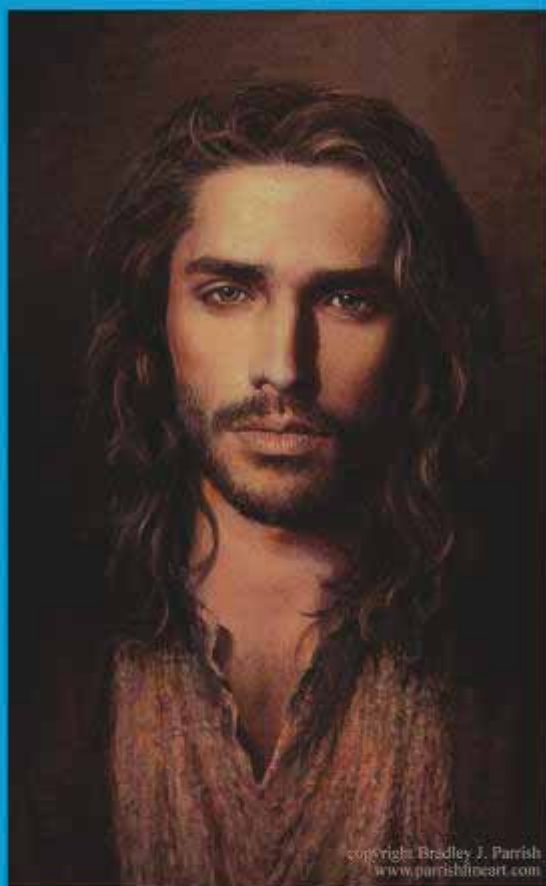

Reflection from Seminarian Vince Racanelli



Last Saturday, I was able to attend the regional confirmation at St. Francis Xavier with Fr. Bart and the young people from our parish. After the homily, the *confirmandi* all testified that they were prepared for Confirmation and lined up to receive an anointing on the forehead with the oil of Sacred Chrism. As Msgr. Bartylla anointed each person, he spoke the words “Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit.” Since we already are temples of the Holy Spirit from Baptism, what does it mean for us to “be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit” at Confirmation?

Like Baptism, Confirmation is one of the three Sacraments of Initiation. At Baptism, we are initiated into the Body of Christ and welcomed into the family of God. At Confirmation, we receive power to participate in the mission of the Church, which is to bear witness to Jesus Christ and to draw others to Him. In other words we are to be evangelizers. As Jesus teaches in the Parable of the Talents, we are not meant to bury His gifts, but rather to put them to good use. We who have received the power of the Holy Spirit likewise share the responsibility to participate in the evangelizing mission of the Church.

El sábado pasado, asistí la confirmación regional en la parroquia de St. Francis Xavier con el padre Bart y los jóvenes de la parroquia. Después de la homilía, los *confirmandi* testificaron que se habían preparado para la confirmación y se formaron en una fila para recibir la unción en la frente con el aceite de la crisma. Cuando el Monseñor Bartylla ungió a los jóvenes, pronunció las palabras “sea sellado con el Don del Espíritu Santo.” Ya que somos templos del Espíritu Santo desde el bautismo, ¿qué significa para nosotros que somos sellados “con el Don del Espíritu Santo” en la confirmación?

Como el bautismo, la confirmación es uno de los tres sacramentos de la iniciación. En el bautismo, nos hacemos parte del Cuerpo de Cristo y recibimos la bienvenida a la familia de Dios; en la confirmación, recibimos el poder del Espíritu Santo para participar en la misión de la Iglesia. Esta misión es testificar a Jesucristo y guiar a los otros a Él. En una palabra: la evangelización. Como enseña Jesús en la parábola de los talentos, no debemos enterrar los dones de Dios, sino usarlos bien. Nosotros que hemos recibido el poder y Don del Espíritu Santo asimismo compartimos la responsabilidad de participar en la misión de la Iglesia.

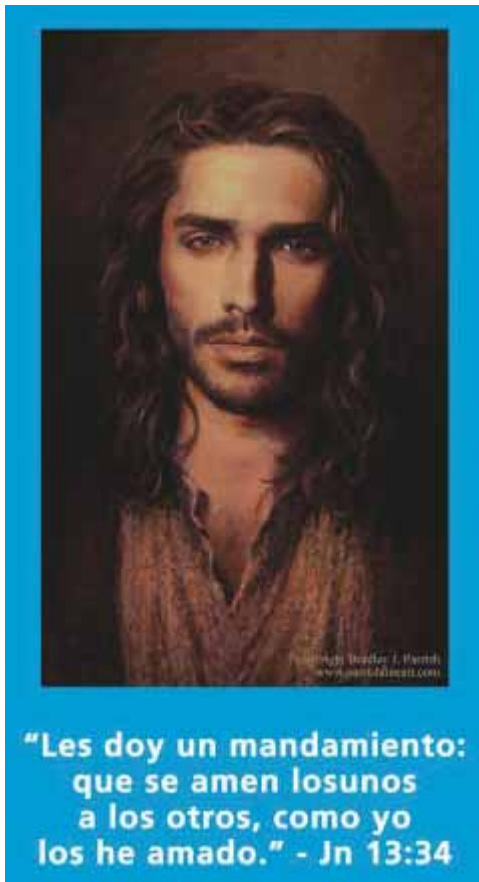
