## Reflection from Seminarian Vince Racanelli



Last week we started our reflection on the sacrament of Confirmation, which our young people received earlier this month. We started with the words of the sacrament, “be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit,” and introduced how confirmation draws us into the Church’s mission of evangelization. We’ll explore the theme of evangelization a little later, but first we’ll return to the question of what it means for us to be “sealed.”

Confirmation, like Baptism and Holy Orders, marks us with a spiritual “seal,” much like the wax seals we sometimes see on wedding invitations. But unlike a wax seal, the sacramental seal can never be lost or destroyed; we will bear those spiritual marks on our souls into eternity. So what does this seal *do*? First, the seal calls out for and is a promise of grace. As long as we do not put any obstacles (i.e., mortal sin) in the way, God *will* give us the grace of the sacrament. This grace has the power to transform us from timid disciples into bold witnesses to the love and call of Jesus, as the apostles were transformed at Pentecost. So how do we draw on this grace then? We’ll explore that question next week.

La semana pasada, empezamos con un comentario sobre el sacramento de la confirmación, lo cual recibieron los jóvenes de nuestra parroquia este mes. Comenzamos con las palabras del sacramento, “sea sellado con el Don del Espíritu Santo,” e introducimos la manera en que la confirmación nos lleva a la misión de la iglesia de evangelizar. Vamos a explorar la tema de la evangelización más al rato, pero primero vamos a regresar a la cuestión del sello.

La confirmación, como el bautismo y las sagradas ordenes, nos marca con un “sello” espiritual, muy parecido a los sellos de cera que vemos en las invitaciones de boda. Distinto a los sellos de cera, el sello sacramental no se puede perder o destruir nunca; llevamos estas marcas en nuestras almas hasta la eternidad. Entonces, ¿qué es la función de los sellos? Primero, el sello clama por la gracia y es una promesa de la gracia. En tanto que no obstruimos la gracia con obstáculos (los pecados mortales), Dios nos dará la gracia del sacramento. Esta gracia tiene el poder de transformarnos de discípulos tímidos a testigos atrevidos de la caridad y vocación de Jesucristo, como los apóstoles se transformaron en el Pentecostés. Entonces, ¿cómo recibimos esta gracia? Vamos a explorar esa cuestión la próxima semana.
