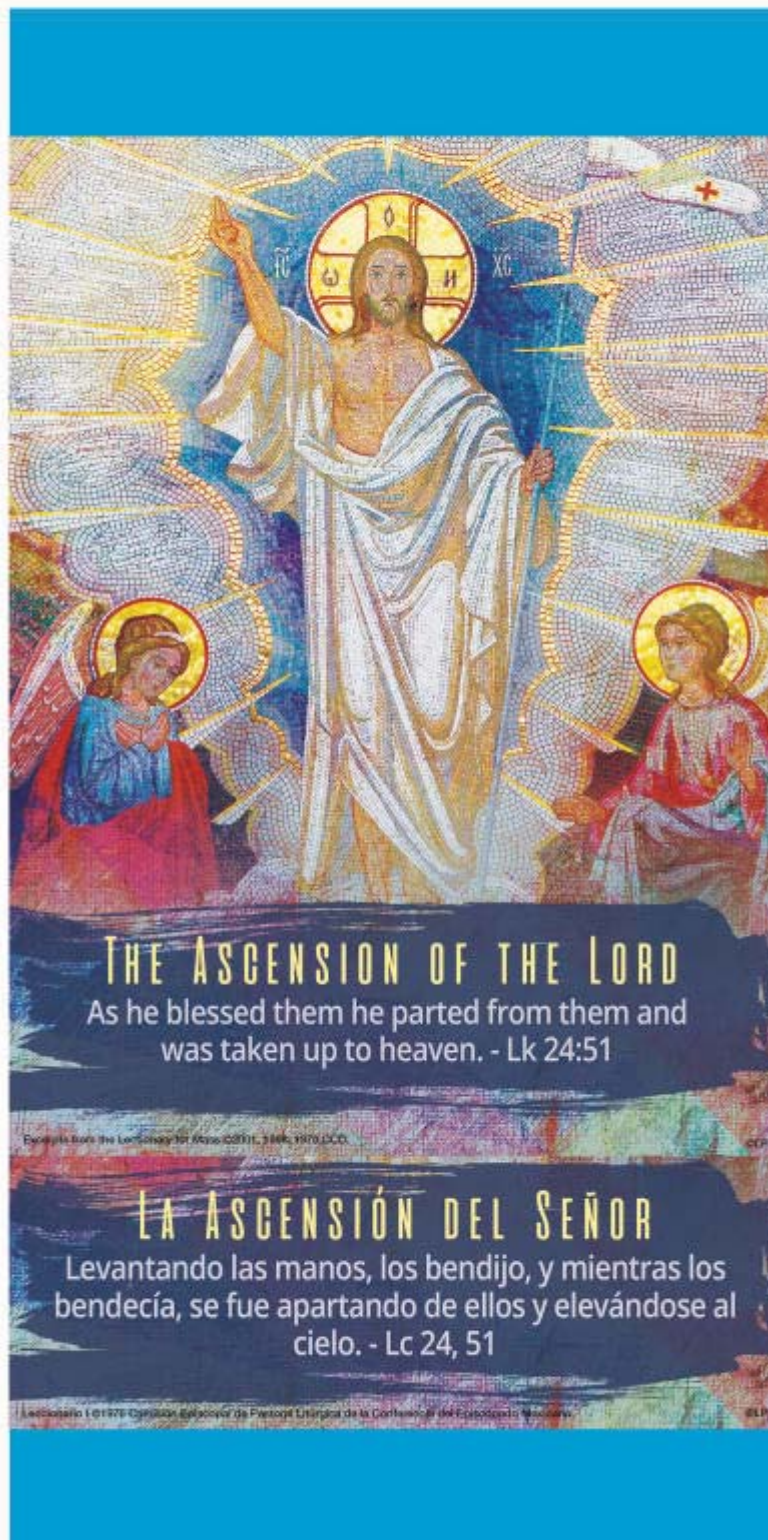

Ascension of the Lord

Christ's Ascension marks the definitive entrance of Jesus' humanity into God's heavenly domain, whence He will come again (cf. *Acts 1:11*); this humanity in the meantime hides Him from the eyes of men (cf. *Col 3:3*). Jesus Christ, the head of the Church,

precedes us into the Father's glorious kingdom so that we, the members of His Body, may live in the hope of one day being with Him forever. Jesus Christ, having entered the sanctuary of heaven once and for all, intercedes constantly for us as the mediator who assures us of the permanent outpouring of the Holy Spirit. (*The Catechism of the Catholic Church* 665-667)

Through the gift of the Holy Spirit, Jesus is present with us in an even more powerful way, than before the Ascension. This weekend we will officially begin a new Prayer Ministry here at St. Thomas Aquinas. We have volunteers who have graciously offered to pray with and for those who come forward with special petitions and intentions for themselves and for others. Thank you for your support of this new ministry, which really is a continuing fruit of the Parish Renewal that we experienced with Deacon Keith Strohm at the beginning of the Easter Season.

Holy Spirit Novena

Novenas (from Latin word, *Novem*, meaning nine) are an ancient tradition that goes back to the days of the Apostles. Jesus told His disciples to pray together after His ascension into heaven, so they went to an upper room along with the Blessed Virgin Mary, (*Acts 1:14*) and joined constantly in prayer for nine days. These nine days of constant prayer by the Apostles at the direction of Jesus led up to Pentecost. This is when the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples as "tongues of fire" (*Acts 2:1-4*). This pattern of 9 days of prayer is the basis the novenas we pray today.

A Novena to the Holy Spirit begins on Friday, May 30 and ends Saturday, June 8. On Sunday, June 9, we will celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit in a powerful way on Pentecost Sunday. Please join in this prayer to the Holy Spirit and prepare yourself for a personal Pentecost:

"Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth. O, God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations. Through Christ our Lord. Amen"

10 Signs of a True Disciple:

1. Desire to see Jesus' face in prayer

4. Sorrow for our sins through Confession
5. Trust that the Holy Spirit heals
6. Detachment from whatever keeps me from loving God and others

8. Concern for souls
9. Joy to share faith with others
10. Peace through unity in Christ's Church

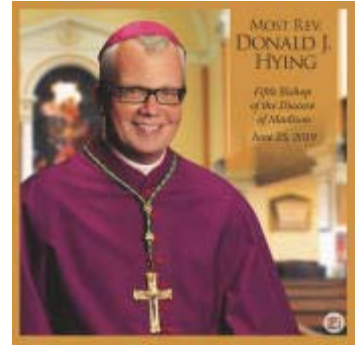

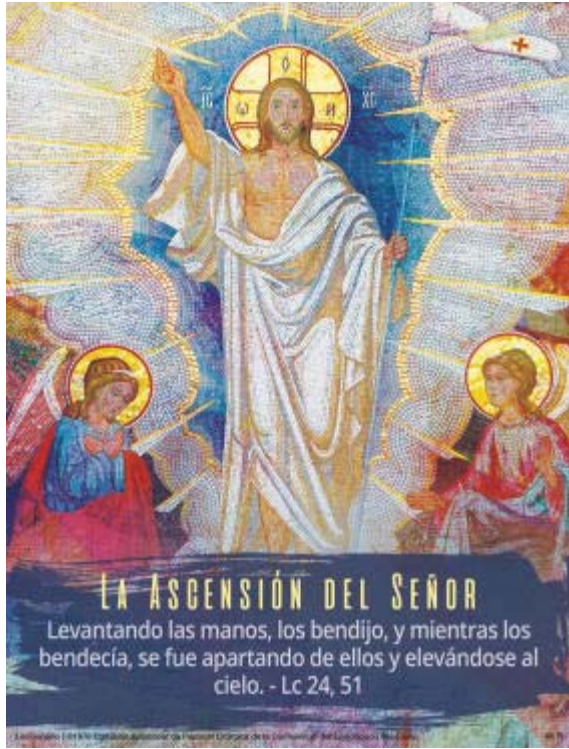
