Solemnity of Pentecost

Happy Pentecost Sunday! The descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost prepared Mary and the Apostles for their respective post-Ascension missions. The tongues of fire that appeared in the Upper Room infused their hearts and minds with charisms and gifts required for their vital mission of evangelizing the world: worshipping, preaching, teaching, healing, administrating, serving and unifying the people of God. The Holy Spirit effected their transformation into Christ.

Christ did not send the Apostles forth immediately following His ascension. He directed them to the holy ground of the Upper Room where He had instituted two key sacraments for the birth of the Church: the sacrament of His body and blood—the Eucharist—and the sacrament of Holy Orders—the priesthood. Christ sent them to the Upper Room to be near Mother Mary who would prepare them to receive and respond to the Holy Spirit in an altogether new way of holy conviction.

Let us pray: "Holy Spirit, please come anew; fill me with your love, life, joy, peace, and wisdom as I pray for my personal Pentecost through the intercession of your beloved spouse, the Virgin Mary. Amen."

New Feast Day of Mary, Mother of the Church, Monday June 10

This new feast day, which Pope Francis added to our liturgical calendar last year for the first time, is to be celebrated annually the day after Pentecost. The decree announcing this feast day explained that the pope approved the celebration because he thought it might "encourage the growth of the maternal sense of the church in the pastors, religious and faithful, as well as a growth of genuine Marian piety."

That idea of Mary interceding for the church, as a mother does for her children, is important for Catholics to consider, especially as this new feast falls so soon after Mother's Day. It is also key to understand the feast day's placement right after Pentecost, noting that at

Reflection from Seminarian

We'll be taking a brief break from our reflections on confirmation and the mission of the Church in order to briefly examine the diaconate. As you may be aware, I was ordained a deacon by Archbishop ListECKI on May 24 by the laying on of his hands, as seen in the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 6:6). The question is now, what are deacons?



Firstly, ordination to the diaconate is one of the three levels of the sacrament of Holy Orders. Like baptism and confirmation, Holy Orders marks the soul with a sacramental seal which can never be lost or destroyed. Just as a baptized person can never stop being baptized, a deacon can never stop being a deacon; the same applies to priests and bishops, who comprise the other two levels of Holy Orders. By their ordination, deacons are sacramentally configured to the person of Christ the Servant, and are called to continually model their lives on his, with the help of God.

Another question is, what can deacons do? Well, deacons are ordinary ministers of baptism and ordinary ministers of Holy Communion, can witness weddings and preside at funerals, impart Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, preach, and bless persons and objects (although you have to ask for the blessing first). So far, giving blessings has been one of my favorite things, so don't be afraid to ask!

Esta semana vamos a pausar en las reflexiones sobre la confirmación y la misión de la iglesia para examinar el diaconado. Como ya puedan saber, recibí la ordenación al diaconado por los manos del arzobispo ListECKI el 24 de mayo por medio de la imposición de manos, como se puede ver en los Hechos de los apóstoles (Hechos 6:6). Preguntamos ahora, ¿qué es un diacono?

La ordenación al diaconado es uno de los niveles del sacramento de las sagradas órdenes. Como el bautismo y la confirmación, las sagradas órdenes marcan el alma con un sellado sacramental lo cual nunca se puede perder ni destrozarse. En la manera en cual una persona bautizada no puede dejar de ser bautizada, un diacono no puede dejar de ser diacono jamás. Por la ordenación, los diáconos se configuran a la persona de Cristo el servidor y tienen la vocación de modelar la vida en la vida de Él, con la ayuda de Dios.

¿Qué hacen los diáconos? Los diáconos son ministros ordinarios del bautismo y de la Sagrada comunión; pueden atestiguar las bodas y presidir sobre los ritos fúnebres, dar la bendición del Santísimo sacramento, predicar, y bendecir a personas y objetos (pero hay que pedir las bendiciones). A mí me encanta bendecir, así que ¡no tengan miedo de pedir una bendición!

Miniature priest vestments help us teach children about the Mass, and are some of the things we need to have made.

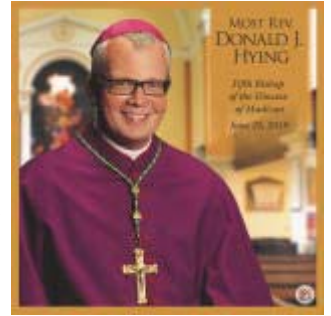
Models of a baptismal font and tabernacle are part of teaching about the sacraments. If you are a woodworker, you could help us by making items like these.

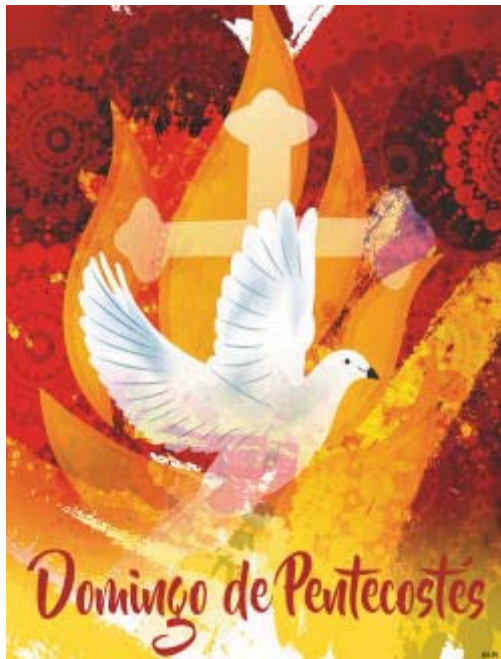
