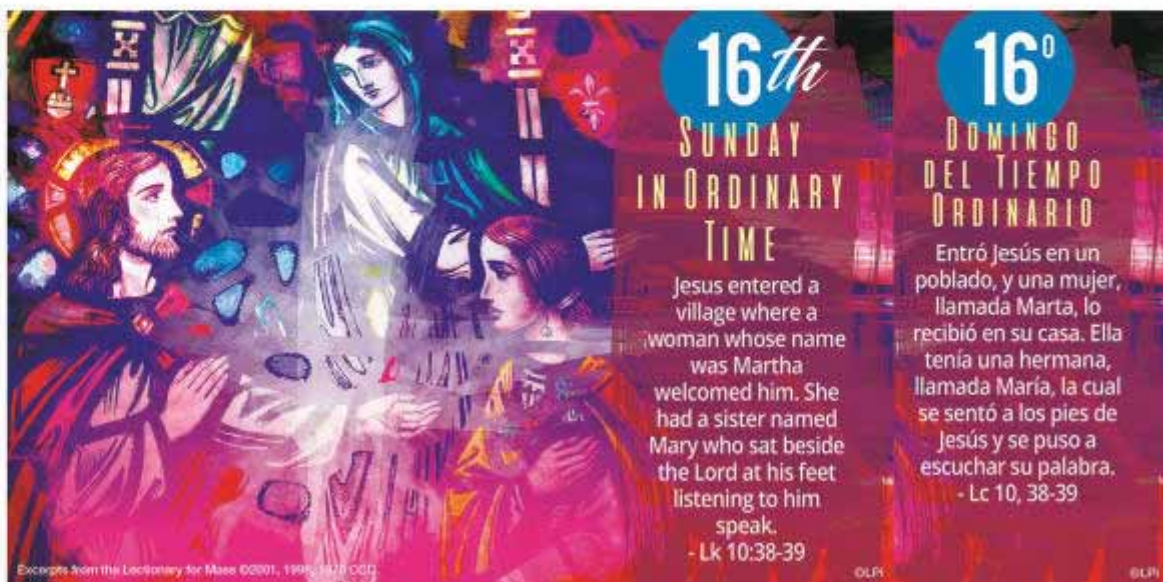

Sixteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

It is so easy to be consumed by activities, checking boxes, crossing items off lists. There can be great satisfaction in acting this way and a tremendous sense of accomplishment. But we hear a different message with other priorities today. Rather than

busy ourselves or stir ourselves into a frenzy, it is the proper role of a disciple to listen to Jesus' instruction. We are invited to spend time in prayer, or with Scripture, coming to know the person of Jesus in a better way. This is critical for any disciple of Jesus. Mary in the Gospel offers us an example. How might you find more time in your daily life to sit at Jesus' feet and listen?

National Natural Family Planning Awareness Week July 21 - 27

To mark Natural Family Planning Awareness (NFP) Week, this Sunday at St. Thomas Aquinas, we focus our attention on NFP methods and Church teachings which support their use in marriage. All engaged couples are introduced to NFP during our Marriage Preparation Program.



As a parish family we encourage our families who are practicing NFP and thank them for their faithful witness to the teachings of the Church in their marriages. NFP calls for sacrifice and communication between married couples. We celebrate NFP Sunday with you and pray for the grace to live as faithful disciples of the Lord Jesus. For those couples who do not practice NFP, we encourage you to become educated about this method and prayerfully consider practicing this method that our Church promotes.

The Church teaches that the sacrament of marriage symbolizes Christ's relationship with His Church. What is this relationship but one of total, faithful, permanent, and fruitful love!

When couples live their vocation according to Church teachings, especially with regard to the transmission of life, many benefits can be reaped. Indeed, married couples who use NFP report that among these benefits is their mutual growth in holiness and consequent deepening of their respect and awe of God's gifts of human sexuality, marriage and family. These are gifts that call for praise!

The dates of Natural Family Planning Awareness Week highlight the anniversary of the papal encyclical *Humanae Vitae* (July 25) which articulates Catholic beliefs about human sexuality, conjugal love and responsible parenthood. The dates also mark the feast of Saints Joachim and Anne (July 26), the parents of the Blessed Mother. For further information, contact nfp@usccb.org.

Reflection from Seminarian Dcn. Vince Racanelli

Methods of Discipleship

As students of the Master, we are called to follow and learn from Him, taking His yoke upon ourselves (cf. Mt. 11:29), so that we are able to imitate Him in every aspect of His life (cf. 1 Cor. 11:1). Now that's a tall order. How do we go about doing that? Well, a good start is to get to know Jesus; and one of the best ways to do that is to read scripture on a regular, if not daily, basis. Even five minutes a day adds up over time.

But even if we are reading scripture, the imitation of Christ is not something we can achieve on our own. We need His help to transform us into His image, and we can receive His help from the sacraments (especially confession and the Eucharist), and from our daily prayer. If we can find time on a daily basis to come before Him in the silence or in front of His presence in the Tabernacle, He can work wonders in our hearts, and we can hear His voice more clearly. And perhaps over time, if we are consistent in our mental prayer, we may even find ourselves calmer, more recollected, and at greater peace, even amidst our hectic schedules!

Métodos del Discipulado

Como estudiantes del Maestro, somos llamados a seguirlo a Él y aprender de Él, tomando Su yugo sobre nosotros (cit. Mt 11:29), para que seamos capaces de imitarlo a Él en cada aspecto de Su vida (cit. 1 Cor 11:1). Ahora esa es una orden grande. ¿Cómo hacemos eso? Bueno, un buen comienzo es el empezar a conocer a Jesús; y una de las mejores maneras de hacer eso es el leer la escritura regularmente, si no diariamente. Aunque sea por cinco minutos, un día se suma a través del tiempo. Pero aunque leamos la escritura, la imitación de Cristo no es algo que podemos lograr por nuestra cuenta; necesitamos Su ayuda para que nos transforme en Su imagen, y podemos recibir Su ayuda mediante los sacramentos (en especial la confesión y la Eucaristía), y también mediante nuestra oración diaria. Si podemos encontrar tiempo diariamente para estar delante de Él en silencio o delante de Su presencia en el Tabernáculo, Él puede obrar maravillas en nuestros corazones, y nosotros podemos escuchar Su voz más claramente. Y quizás con el tiempo, si somos consistentes en nuestra oración mental, podemos encontrarnos más tranquilos, más recolectados, y con una mayor paz, en medio de nuestros horarios frenéticos.

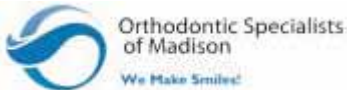
