Nineteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

We do not know the hour or the day when the Son of Man will come or when we will go to meet the Him. How are you exercising vigilance in preparation for this moment? We are advised to act in a way that we will be ready for the day of Judgment.

May Jesus find us ready, not standing still, but working and loving, building up His Kingdom, and doing His will!

The Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary into Heaven Gives Us Hope!

On Thursday, August 15, we will celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holy Day of Obligation. We have a new Holy Day Mass Schedule, so please check the new times.

Sixty-nine years ago, on November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII solemnly defined the Dogma of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This Dogma states that at the end of her earthly life, Mary was taken up, body and soul, into heaven, that is, into the glory of eternal life, into full and perfect communion with God.

In the Catholic Church, a dogma is a definitive article of faith that has been solemnly proclaimed and put into effect by the teaching authority of the Catholic Church, the Magisterium. This authority is exercised in either of two ways:

- by the college of bishops at an ecumenical council
- or*
- by the pope, when speaking “ex cathedra.”
- When a pope speaks, “ex cathedra,” he is giving an authoritative teaching that is necessary for all Catholics to believe. The First Vatican Council (1868-1870) declared that all statements made by the pope “ex cathedra,” are Infallible when he is issuing an official teaching on matters of faith and morals. Infallible statements are exempt or immune to error or failure.

As Catholics, we believe that Mary, like Christ her Son, overcame death and is already triumphant in heavenly glory, in the totality of her being,” in body and soul.” The Church teaches that Mary, the Mother of God, is so deeply integrated into Christ's Mystery that at the end of her earthly life she already participates with her whole self in her Son's Resurrection. She lives what awaits us at the end of time when the “last enemy,” death, will have been destroyed (cf. 1 Cor. 15: 26); she already lives what we proclaim in the Creed: “I look forward to the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come.”

At the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965), in the Constitution on the Church, the Bishops wrote about Mary, Most Holy. The reflection ends with these words:

The Mother of Jesus in the glory which she possesses in body and soul in heaven is the image and the beginning of the church as it is to be perfected in the world to come. Likewise, she shines forth on earth, until the day of the Lord shall come (no. 68).

In the light of this most beautiful image of our Mother, and as we celebrate her Assumption into Heaven, we are able to be encouraged in HOPE! Our hope to one day enter into heavenly glory when our time on earth is completed.

Hope is a gift from God that carries us forward with our eyes fixed on heaven. Do not allow yourself to be robbed of hope. As disciples of Jesus Christ, we have hope in eternal life, even when we are

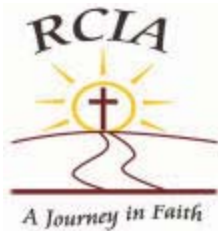


Interested in Becoming Catholic?

I want to encourage our STA family to attend the Holy Day of Obligation Bilingual Mass on Thursday, August 15, as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary into Heaven. I hope that we can fill the Church to capacity and make it feel like everyone is present. Bishop Hying, since being installed as the Fifth Bishop of Madison, has made a great effort to visit parishes all over the diocese, and I hope we also can make a great effort to welcome *him*.

Every Holy Day, we have a bilingual Mass in the evening, as we try to gather our whole community together as one family. Some people would prefer the Mass entirely in Spanish or in English. However, there is value in praying together including both languages and both cultures, so that we can be united as a single Parish Family at the same Mass. We do not want to form two separate groups, we want to be united as one parish family. In addition, it is not easy for me to offer the Mass separately in both languages due to so many other obligations.

Our Thursday Mass will be Bishop Hying's first chance to address and pray with the Hispanic Community of Madison as our Bishop. We look forward to hearing his homily and message for us! Bishop Hying speaks Spanish well because of his three years as a pastor of a parish in the Dominican Republic. I look forward to praying with all of you as we welcome Bishop Hying to STA.

Music & Liturgy

In just over a month, we will begin our fall rehearsal schedule at St. Thomas Aquinas. There are many opportunities for students and adults to become involved. If you are currently involved as a musician, choir member, or cantor here at St. Thomas Aquinas, Thank You! If you are not currently involved in our Music Ministry, Now is the time to consider becoming involved!

Here are a few of the ways to get involved:

Cantor/Small Ensemble: Saturday at 4:30 PM / Sunday at 8:00 AM and Summer Months – Sunday at 10:00 AM

The cantor's function is to support and encourage the congregation in singing. They are our song leaders, animators, and psalmists. Cantors should possess a beautiful singing voice and be able to animate our sung texts with musicality and clear articulation. – Join any time. Contact me for more information.

STA Parish Choir: Sunday at 10:00 AM – September – May

The STA Choir sings weekly at the 10:00 AM Sunday Mass. In addition, this group sings for evening Holy Day Masses, Midnight Mass, Triduum, Confirmation, and other Liturgical Celebrations during the Church Year. This choir is open to students (grade 7 and up) and adults. Rehearsals are Thursdays from 6:30 to 8:30 PM – Our first rehearsal is scheduled for Thursday, September 5. Please contact me ahead of time if you are interested in joining us or would like more information, so that I can have things prepared for our first rehearsal.

STA Choristers: Saturday at 4:30 PM and/or Sunday at 10:00 AM, Once or Twice a Month – September – May

The STA Choristers sing monthly at the 4:30 PM Saturday Mass and/or the Sunday 10:00 AM Mass. In addition, this group has the opportunity to sing for other celebrations, including Thanksgiving and Christmas Eve Masses. This choir sings from September through May each year, and is open to students (grades

4-8) as well as high school students. Rehearsals are most often on Wednesday from 5:00 to 6:00 PM – Our first rehearsal is scheduled for Wednesday, September 4 at 5:00 PM. Please share the word and let's get some more of our students involved!

STA Spanish Choir: (Sunday at 6:30 pm)

The STA Spanish Choir sings weekly at the 6:30 PM Sunday Mass and joins the STA Parish Choir for bilingual celebrations throughout the Liturgical Year. This choir sings year round and is open to students (grade 7 and up) and adults. Rehearsals are on Sundays at 5:15 PM before the Spanish Mass. – Join any time. Contact me for more information or come and join us on Sunday at 5:15 PM in the Music Room!

Instrumentalists & Accompanists: (All Masses)

We also need Instrumentalists and accompanists for our music ministry, depending upon experience. We are also seeking a choir accompanist (piano and/or organ) to support our choir members and help them to grow in their musicality and execution of beautifully composed choral music. 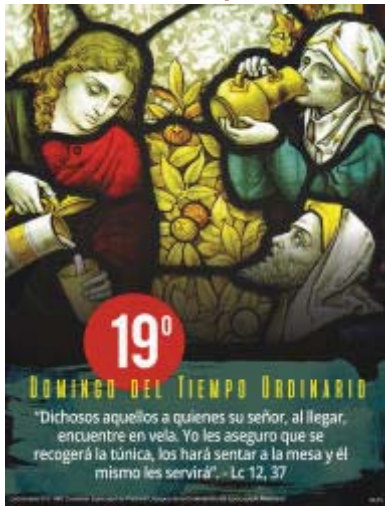
