Christ the King

This Sunday is the last Sunday in the Roman Catholic Church year when we celebrate the Feast of the Solemnity of Jesus Christ the Sovereign King.

The ancients were fond of a Latin phrase "Carpe Diem", which literally means "Seize the day." For we who are living in communion in Christ Jesus, that phrase can take on a whole new meaning. We always journey toward the "Day of the Lord," when He will return as King. We should seize that day as the reference point for all things and live our lives as though His day is the milestone and marker for all that we do, revealing the path along which we become new, beginning now—because it is.

Our Catholic liturgical year follows a rhythmic cycle which points us toward beginnings and endings. In doing so, it emphasizes an important truth that can only be grasped through faith. Our Catholic faith and its Liturgical practices proclaim to a world hungry for meaning that Jesus Christ is the "Alpha," (the first letter of the Greek alphabet) and the "Omega" (the last letter), the beginning and the end. He is the Giver, the Governor and the fulfillment of all time. In Him the whole world is being made new and every end is a new beginning.

Welcome Bishop Hying

We are blessed to welcome our bishop, Bishop Donald Hying to St. Thomas Aquinas for his second pastoral visit since being installed as Bishop. Bishop Hying will preside at our Spanish Mass at 6:30 PM on Sunday evening as we conclude the Liturgical Year with the Feast of Christ the King. Bishop Hying's presence with our Hispanic community is a strong signal from our leader that as a Church we need to be a Church that welcomes and serves all Catholics in our diocese, people of every race, language, and culture. In a special way, the Church and our Bishop have a heart for the very large immigrant Hispanic population present in our neighborhoods, and we want to be equipped to serve them.

At the same time we reach out in service to others, the Hispanic community also offers their gifts to us. We have a reciprocal and enriching relationship with one another within the Church. We have our own unique gifts and faith to share with each other. For example, one gift that we have been blessed to receive from our Hispanic community members is their great love and devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. We see this in an awesome way on the Feast Day of Our Lady of Guadalupe on December 12. What a great blessing it is to welcome Bishop Hying and conclude the last Mass of our Liturgical Year with him, our Good Shepherd, at STA Parish!

Advent begins!

As we begin the season of Advent, we begin a new Liturgical Year! Each week during our Entrance procession, we will hear the chant, "Veni, Veni Emmanuel/O Come, O Come Emmanuel," and then sing together, "Come, Emmanuel." "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel" is a text that was originally written in Latin, based on the O Antiphons, a series of plainchant antiphons sung at Vespers/Evening Prayer during the final days before Christmas. The 1861 translation by John Mason Neale from Hymns Ancient and Modern is the most prominent by far in the English-speaking world.
