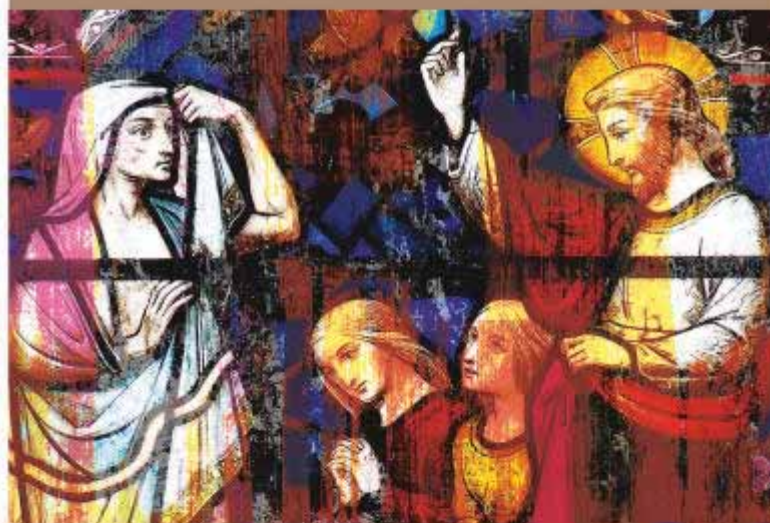

Fifth Sunday of Lent

As Christians, we live our lives to conform to the paschal mystery- the truth that from death comes life. Looking at today's readings from Ezekiel and the Gospel of John, we can ponder this mystery both literally (we will rise from the death) and figuratively. We might ask, where are we being called forth from "tombs" within our own lives to embrace life anew? As we move closer to Easter, we continue our Lenten work of healing and reconciliation. This week we try and recognize any "tombs" that keep us chained up and buried, preventing us from living life with Christ. During this pandemic health emergency, I want to be freed from the "tomb" of worry and despair over what has befallen our human family and the negative effects this is having on all of us. We must stay positive and hopeful as Christians, knowing that Christ has won the victory over sin and death and has set us free, he calls us out of our "tombs" as he called Lazarus.

Financial Challenge

There isn't much doubt that the covid-19 pandemic has managed to affect almost all aspects of our lives. Work, school, travel and worship have all been suspended, cut back or ceased altogether. It is a challenge for every business or institution to keep functioning as best we can. For St. Thomas Aquinas, our financial outlook has changed suddenly and dramatically. We have suffered even greater changes in our finances due to the suspension of the public Masses.

We realize that some parishioners will have their own income affected by the pandemic, and we understand if they are unable to contribute. But we ask that others who have not been negatively impacted by all the shutdowns and suspensions, to continue supporting STA if you can. We still have substantial expenses that must be met. So please consider some other methods of sending in your support. We encourage you to consider using our auto deposit system that collects your monthly contribution automatically as a deduction from your bank account, or as a charge to your credit card (both are available). You can also simply mail your contribution in as well. In addition, you can now donate from our website at stamadison.org/donate/ using PayPal. But please don't forget about us! We need your support. To begin auto deposit, please call Patrick O'Loughlin during our regular business hours to set this up. Thank you for all you do for our STA Family!

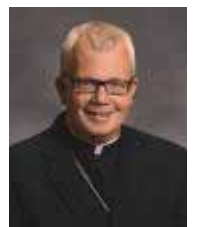

Tips on Isolation From a Cloistered Nun

For the past 29 years, I've chosen to practice social distancing. Of course, I and the 17 other nuns I live with don't call it that.

We are formally called cloistered sisters, meaning we never leave our walled-off monastery in Summit except for doctors' visits or perhaps shopping for a specific item.

As someone who has lived a life of separation, I'd like to share from my experience how you can make the best of it.

First, you need to establish structure.

Your normal day-to-day lives have structure imposed on them from the outside; you have to catch the train at a certain time to go to work, you have school recess at the same time every day. These things give you a sense of consistency and rhythm.

Now that you are stuck at home, create a schedule for yourself and your family. At the monastery, we wake up at the same time every day and get fully dressed (no pajamas).

Second, be intentional and love others.

It is easy to get caught up in making sure you and your loved ones are safe and your needs are met. We are in uncharted territory and these reactions are understandable. However, we should fight against self-centered urges. Call older people in your neighborhood and ask how they are doing, if they need

anything. Give the gift of your time. Cook meals with your family and play games.

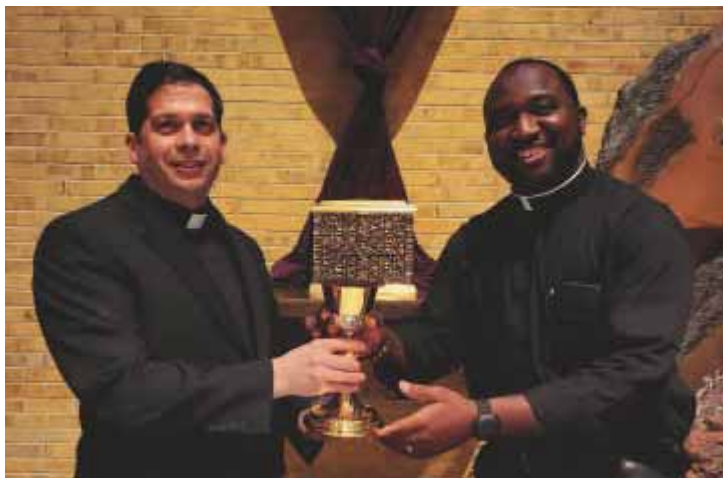
Third, use this time for self-reflection and relaxation.

"I need a vacation to recover from my vacation!" people say. Well, this could be it. These weeks are your opportunity for a more quiet, simple life. Every day after lunch, my sisters and I take a 90-minute break of "profound silence." We don't move around the building or talk. We stay still. We read, pray or reflect. Sometimes, we will do a hobby quietly. Sometimes, we nap.

Stop. Be still. You can either waste this period of social-distancing and be frustrated, or you can choose to make it the best it can be.

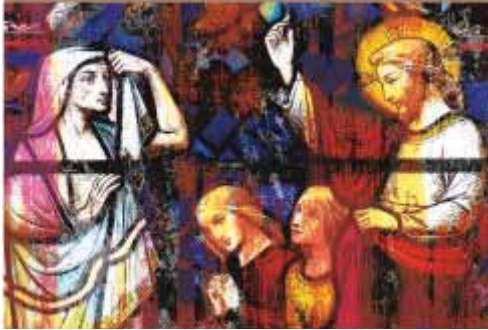
