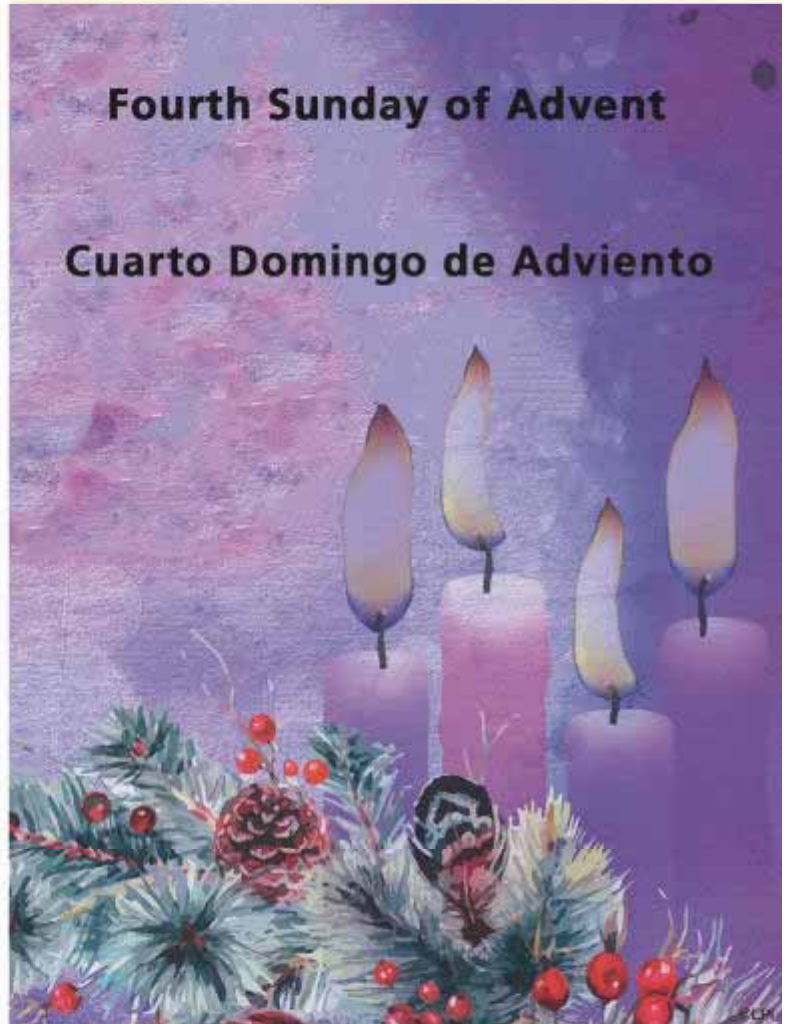

End of Calendar-Year Giving

The last regular Sunday offertory collection of the year will be the weekend following Christmas, the Feast of the Holy Family, December 26 and 27. This year has been an unpredictable time. Given the steep decline in Mass attendance due to the health pandemic, we are blessed that so many have continued to support the mission of our parish by giving automatically, online, and through the mail. This gives me confidence, despite the anticipated low turnout for our Christmas Masses, that as a parish family, we will all do our best to help our parish meet our financial commitments. If you are able, this is the time to complete your pledge you made last year. To take advantage of a tax deduction for all 2020 contributions, the following guidelines are offered:

- All hand-delivered 2020 contributions must be received in the parish office no later than 3:00 PM on Thursday, December 31, 2020.
- All mailed 2020 contributions must be postmarked by December 31, 2020.

Gospel Reflection By Dcn. Jerome Buhman

Let’s be honest – one of the really fun parts about Christmas is opening gifts. Picking up the present, wondering what it could be, finally opening it to reveal what is inside. I remember when I was a kid, opening presents from my parents, I was always a little nervous – would it be a fun toy or ... maybe (*sigh*) socks.

One of the beautiful things displayed in today’s readings is opening oneself to God. In the first reading, David has a grand plan to build God a temple – but that wasn’t God’s plan for David. David opened himself to God and discarded his own plans to follow the will of God. In the Gospel, Mary is troubled by the angel’s message, but she opens herself totally to God’s will: “May it be done to me according to your word.”

This Christmas when we are opening our presents, let us think about how we are opening ourselves to God and to his word in our lives – the gift we receive from that will be invaluable.

Cares Act

Did you know there are certain tax benefits of the CARES act that must be completed by December 31, 2020 to be effective? Here are some provisions that pertain directly or indirectly to charitable giving and only apply to 2020:

- **If you do not itemize:** You are still able to claim charitable deduction of up to \$300 in cash gifts. The \$300 applies for either a single or a married couple.
- **Higher deductibility limits for 2020:** The deductibility of cash donations increased from 60% to 100% of your adjusted gross income (AGI) for 2020. This would be a useful strategy if you are considering a large cash gift or accelerating payment on a pledge.
- **Higher deductibility limits for corporations in 2020:** If you are a decision-maker for a corporation, the deduction limit for cash contributions from corporate donors has been raised from 10% to 25% of adjusted gross income for 2020.
- **IRA Charitable Rollover:** Unchanged this year, is the provision that permits persons 70 ½ or older to authorize the administrator of their IRA to transfer up to \$100,000 cumulatively to a charity or charities **TAX-FREE**.
- **Any deductible gift is time-sensitive and must be completed prior to December 31, 2020. For more information, check with your tax accountant soon!**

Please RSVP if You Plan to Attend Christmas Mass

Due to COVID-19, we can only safely seat about 30% of our normal capacity, and it is likely that the parish will hit this limit at one or more Christmas Masses. Therefore, **it is essential that you RSVP for Christmas Mass if you want to attend.** Even if you are not completely sure exactly how many people will come with you or you may change your mind at the last minute, it is better to reserve a place on our list than to wait and find out that the Mass you want is already full. You can modify or cancel your reservation after you make it.

Note: a reservation means you will be admitted to one of the seating areas in the building; it does NOT guarantee you will be able to sit in the church itself—people who arrive after our main worship space reaches its capacity will be seated in the chapel or social hall. People in those rooms will participate in the Mass by video, and extraordinary ministers will bring Holy Communion to them.

If we have room for walk-ins at a Mass, they will be seated in the Social Hall.

The parish is doing its very best to balance our desire not to turn anyone away from Mass with the real and pressing need to keep everyone as safe as possible during the COVID-19 pandemic. Your RSVP will help us meet those goals.

We also remind you of Bishop Hying's video message a few weeks ago in which he encouraged everyone at increased risk from the coronavirus to be extra cautious and avoid attending Mass in person. You can listen to Bishop Hying's guidance at stamadison.org/bishop-hying-message-fall-2020/.

Debido a COVID-19, solo podemos sentar con seguridad alrededor del 30% de nuestra capacidad normal, y es probable que la parroquia alcance este límite en una o más de las Misas de Navidad. Por lo tanto, **es esencial que confirme su asistencia a la Misa de Navidad si desea asistir.** Incluso si no está completamente seguro de cuántas personas vendrán con usted o si puede cambiar de opinión en el último minuto, es mejor reservar un lugar en nuestra lista que esperar y descubrir que la Misa que desea ya está llena. Puede modificar o cancelar su reserva después de realizarla.

Note que una reservación significa que será admitido en una de las áreas de asientos del edificio, pero NO garantiza que podrá sentarse dentro en la iglesia; las personas que lleguen después de que la iglesia mayor alcance su capacidad, se sentarán en la capilla o en el salón de convivio. Las personas en esos espacios participarán en la Misa por video, y los ministros extraordinarios les traerán la Sagrada Comunión a sus asientos.

Si tenemos espacio adicional para personas sin reservación previa, éstas se sentarán en el Salón de Convivio.
