### Lent Begins on Ash Wednesday February 17

Please join us at Mass or via livestream on Ash Wednesday at 6:30 AM, 12:10 PM, or 6:30 PM. Ash Wednesday Mass is a good way to begin the season of Lent.



This year, instead of the traditional distribution of ashes, we will use the form recommended by the Vatican Liturgy Office (Congregation for Divine Worship) for distributing ashes during a pandemic. After the homily the priest (wearing a face mask) will offer the prayer over ashes and sprinkle them with Holy Water. Then he will say the formula for the distribution of ashes once, addressed to all but separated physically from the people, sanitize his hands, along with the other ministers, and then individually sprinkle ashes over the heads (not on the forehead) of those present without saying anything. There will be no procession forward; the ministers and I will sprinkle the ashes while the faithful remain in their pews as we have been doing for Holy Communion. This eliminates close talking and physical contact.

This is not ideal, and we are disappointed that we will not receive ashes on our foreheads, but during the pandemic we must keep everyone as safe and healthy as possible. This is a good time to remind ourselves that what really matters is what is on the inside, in our hearts. Ash Wednesday ultimately is a day of repentance and sorrow for our sins and changing our hearts to life in Christ. We pray that in the midst of all we are enduring, we can turn our hearts towards God and away from sin.

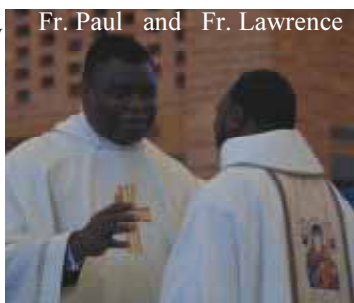
### Make Sundays Special Home Kit

As we continue to Make Sundays Special, I hope that everyone was able to read the booklets we mailed to all the households in our parish. I also hope that each household can pick up their Home Kit or have one delivered. So far we have distributed 165 kits. A strong connection between the domestic Church in our homes and our parish of St. Thomas Aquinas is more important than ever when many people are staying home. ### Celebrating Black Catholics During Black History Month

During February we celebrate black Americans and how their communities have clung tenaciously to faith amidst great hardship. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops estimates that there are 3 million black Catholics in the U.S. and 798 predominantly African-American parishes. There are 250 African-American priests, 437 deacons, 75 men of African descent in seminary formation, 400 African-American religious sisters, and 50 religious brothers. These numbers do not include missionaries from Africa who serve in the United States, like our very own parish son, Fr. Lawrence Oparaji, who was ordained to the priesthood for our Diocese of Madison on February 22, 2020!

Throughout February, I hope to share with you more reasons for us to celebrate Black Catholics during Black History Month!

## Padre Bart Timmerman, Párroco

### La Cuaresma comienza el Miércoles de Ceniza, 17 de febrero

Acompáñenos en la Misa o por transmisión en vivo el Miércoles de Ceniza a las 6:30 AM, 12:10 PM o 6:30 PM. La Misa del Miércoles de Ceniza es una buena manera de comenzar el tiempo de Cuaresma.

Este año, en lugar de la distribución tradicional de las cenizas, usaremos la forma para distribuir las cenizas durante una pandemia recomendada por la Oficina de Liturgia del Vaticano, Congregación para el Culto Divino. Después de la homilía, el sacerdote cubierto con una mascarilla ofrecerá la oración sobre las cenizas y las rociará con agua bendita. Luego dirá la fórmula para la distribución de cenizas una vez, dirigida a todos, pero separado físicamente de la gente, desinfectará sus manos, junto con los otros ministros, y luego esparcirá cenizas individualmente sobre la cabeza de los presentes sin decir nada; no la frente. No habrá procesión hacia el frente; los ministros y yo rociaremos las cenizas mientras los fieles permanezcan en sus bancas como lo hemos estado haciendo para la Sagrada Comunión. Esto elimina la conversación cercana y el contacto físico.

Esto no es lo ideal y nos decepciona que no recibamos cenizas en la frente, pero durante la pandemia debemos mantener a todos lo más seguros y sanos posible. Este es un buen momento para recordarnos a nosotros mismos que lo que realmente importa es lo que está adentro, en nuestro corazón. En última instancia, el Miércoles de Ceniza es un día de arrepentimiento y dolor por nuestros pecados y de cambiar nuestro corazón a la vida en Cristo. Oramos para que, en medio de todo lo que estamos soportando, podamos volver nuestro corazón hacia Dios y alejarnos del pecado.

### Paquete Haz del Domingo un Día Especial para la casa

Mientras continuamos haciendo los domingos días especiales, espero que todos hayan podido leer los folletos que enviamos por correo a todos los hogares de nuestra parroquia. También espero que cada hogar pueda recoger su paquete para la casa o recibir uno. Hasta ahora hemos distribuido 165 paquetes. Una fuerte conexión entre la Iglesia doméstica en nuestros hogares y nuestra parroquia de Santo Tomás de Aquino es más importante que nunca cuando muchas personas se quedan en casa. Extraño vernos a todos juntos en la Misa y es alentador saber que todavía estamos conectados y orando juntos, a pesar de que estamos separados. Gracias a los voluntarios que entregarán los paquetes para la casa y a todos por su atención y participación en esta iniciativa.

### Reconociendo a los católicos negros durante el Mes de la historia afroamericana

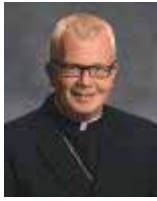
Durante el mes de febrero celebramos a los estadounidenses negros y cómo sus comunidades se han aferrado tenazmente a la fe en medio de grandes dificultades. La Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos de Norteamérica estima que hay 3 millones de católicos negros en los Estados Unidos de Norteamérica y 798 parroquias predominantemente afroamericanas. Hay 250 sacerdotes afroamericanos, 437 diáconos, 75 hombres de ascendencia africana en el seminario de formación, 400 hermanas religiosas afroamericanas y 50 hermanos religiosos. Estos números no incluyen a los misioneros de África que sirven en los Estados Unidos, como nuestro propio hijo parroquial, el Padre Lawrence Oparaji, quien fue ordenado sacerdote para nuestra Diócesis de Madison el 22 de febrero de 2020.

Durante el mes de febrero, espero compartir con ustedes más razones para que celebremos a los católicos negros durante el Mes de la historia afroamericana.

## Gospel Reflection

You think you've had a busy day!? Today's Gospel is a continuation of the one we heard last Sunday. If you remember, Jesus went to Capernaum and taught in the synagogue (with authority!). He then cast a demon out of a man there.



Then, today's Gospel continues that same day in which Jesus travels to Simon and Andrew's house where he heals Simon's mother-in-law (probably against the rules of purity for the Sabbath, showing the importance of compassion over regulations). Then, after sunset (marking the end of the Sabbath), the “whole town” gathered at the door seeking healing. Who knows how late into the night Jesus labored, but he “cured many” and “drove out many demons.” Who would begrudge Jesus if he slept in the next day? Yet he rose “early before dawn” to go pray. Taking time to pray was absolutely essential for Jesus, no matter what was going on in his life. In this way, he sets an example for us. On our busiest days, do we set aside time for prayer? Prayer should be an absolute essential in our lives as well, and we should always make time to talk to God. This Gospel is a good reminder that despite the hurricane of activity that might engulf our lives, prayer is something that we cannot afford to give up. As we approach the season of Lent, it is a good time to reflect: how much time of my busy day do I give to prayer?

## Reflexión del Evangelio

¿Crees que has tenido un día ajetreado? El Evangelio de hoy es una continuación del que escuchamos el domingo pasado. Si recuerdas, Jesús fue a Cafarnaúm y enseñó en la sinagoga con autoridad. Luego expulsó a un demonio de un hombre allí. Luego, el Evangelio de hoy continúa ese mismo día en el que Jesús viaja a la casa de Simón y Andrés, donde sana a la suegra de Simón; probablemente en contra de las reglas de pureza del sábado, mostrando la importancia de la compasión sobre las regulaciones. Luego, después de la puesta del Sol que marca el final del sábado, “todo el pueblo” se reunió a la puerta en busca de curación. Quién sabe cuánto trabajó Jesús hasta altas horas de la noche, pero “curó a muchos” y “expulsó a muchos demonios”. ¿Quién envidiaría a Jesús si se durmiera al día siguiente? Sin embargo, se levantó “temprano antes del amanecer” para ir a orar. Tomarse el tiempo para orar era absolutamente esencial para Jesús, sin importar lo que sucediera en su vida. De esta forma, nos da un ejemplo. En nuestros días más ocupados, ¿reservamos tiempo para la oración? La oración también debe ser absolutamente esencial en nuestras vidas y siempre debemos hacer tiempo para hablar con Dios. Este Evangelio es un buen recordatorio de que, a pesar del huracán de actividades que podría envolver nuestras vidas, la oración es algo a lo que no podemos darnos el lujo de renunciar. Al acercarnos al tiempo de Cuaresma, es un buen momento para reflexionar: ¿cuánto tiempo de mi ajetreado día dedico a la oración?

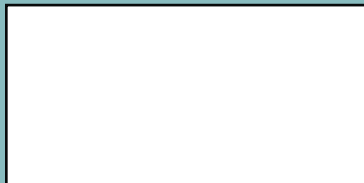
