Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

When Jesus celebrates his last Passover before Good Friday, he gives us the key to understand what will happen. In the guise of a terrible act of violence, the crucifixion is a gift of Jesus in His totality for the salvation of the world. It is the physical enacting of Jesus' words over the bread and wine, "This is my body, this is my blood, which will be given for you." As we read the Passion, let us remember the mystery we are celebrating. Jesus died, but that is not the end of the story. The sorrow of Palm Sunday leads to the overflowing joy of Easter. The ultimate healing of humankind is healing from final death and the gift of eternal life. Let us open ourselves to the gift of Salvation, the healing Jesus offers us through his death and resurrection.

Holy Week:

Celebrating the Heart of Everything We Believe!

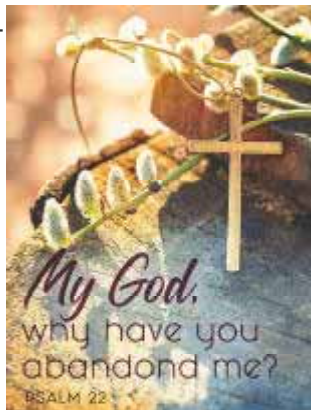
The Easter Triduum starts with the Mass of the Lord's Last Supper on Holy Thursday, reaches its summit at the Easter Vigil, and ends on Easter Sunday. The mystery of Jesus' death and resurrection is a present reality; the boundaries of time, and death, have no power here. Our past, present, and future are irrevocably marked by our immersion into this mystery through baptism. We reverence the cross, light fires in the night and proclaim the stories of our salvation in awed awareness that this is what it means to be baptized. Please join us in these liturgies, either in-person or by livestream. The presence, time, and energy of everyone in the community are needed. This may be inconvenient, but birth and death are rarely convenient! Our forty days of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving lead us to the Triduum—beyond its history, into its mystery.

The Easter Vigil is the premier time to welcome new members into the Church through Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. At STA, we are blessed to be welcoming 2 new members into full communion, and 8 more Catholic adults will complete their initiation at the Easter Vigil or during the Easter Season!

Due to the risk of Covid-19 and Vatican protocols to address it, our Holy Week worship will have some changes this year. To find out about these changes, please see our website, stamadison.org/holy-week-2021-sta, or ask any parish staff member.

Bilingual Masses

During the Triduum, we will include readings and prayers in Spanish at our Holy Thursday and Easter Vigil Masses. Bilingual liturgies unite our entire community, both English-speaking and Spanish-speaking. Thank you for supporting this ministry. Our Bilingual Masses help us pray together and to welcome the stranger, which is an Act of Mercy.

Domingo de Ramos de la Pasión del Señor

Cuando Jesús celebra su última Pascua antes del Viernes Santo, nos da la clave para entender lo que sucederá. Bajo la apariencia de un terrible acto de violencia, la crucifixión es un regalo de Jesús en su totalidad para la salvación del mundo. Es la representación física de las palabras de Jesús sobre el pan y el vino: "Este es mi cuerpo, esta es mi sangre, que será entregada por ustedes". Mientras leemos la Pasión, recordemos el misterio que estamos celebrando. Jesús murió, pero ese no es el final de la historia. El dolor del Domingo de Ramos conduce a la alegría desbordante de la Pascua. La curación definitiva de la humanidad es la curación de la muerte final y el regalo de la vida eterna. Abrámonos al don de la Salvación, la curación que Jesús nos ofrece a través de su muerte y resurrección.

Semana Santa:

¡Celebrando el corazón de todo lo que creemos!

El Triduo Pascual comienza con la Misa de la Última Cena del Señor el Jueves Santo, alcanza su punto culminante en la Vigilia Pascual y finaliza el Domingo de Resurrección. El misterio de la muerte y resurrección de Jesús es una realidad presente; los límites del tiempo y la muerte no tienen poder aquí. Nuestro pasado, presente y futuro están irrevocablemente marcados por nuestra inmersión en este misterio a través del bautismo. Reverenciamos la cruz, encendemos fuegos en la noche y proclamamos las historias de nuestra salvación con la consciencia de que eso es lo que significa ser bautizado. Acompañenos en estas liturgias, ya sea en persona o por transmisión en vivo. Se necesita la presencia, el tiempo y la energía de todos en la comunidad. Esto puede ser un inconveniente, ¡pero el nacimiento y la muerte rara vez son convenientes! Nuestros cuarenta días de oración, ayuno y limosna nos llevan al Triduo, más allá de su historia, hacia su misterio.

La Vigilia Pascual es el momento principal para dar la bienvenida a nuevos miembros a la Iglesia a través del Bautismo, la Confirmación y la Eucaristía. En Saint Thoma Aquinas, tenemos la bendición de dar la bienvenida a dos nuevos miembros en plena comunión, ¡y ocho adultos católicos más completarán su iniciación en la Vigilia Pascual o durante el tiempo de Pascua!

Debido al riesgo del Covid-19 y los protocolos del Vaticano para abordarlo, nuestro culto de Semana Santa tendrá algunos cambios este año. Para conocer estos cambios, visite nuestro sitio web, stamadison.org/holy-week-2021-sta, o pregunte a cualquier miembro del personal de la parroquia.

Gospel Reflection By Dcn. Jerome Buhman

The Palm Sunday liturgy is a study in contrasts. We have Jesus' triumphal entry procession into Jerusalem at the beginning with the crowds waving palm branches and shouting "Hosanna", then later his painful procession to his death on Golgotha with the crowds shouting "Crucify him!" An interesting way to reflect on this is through the word "palm." Did you know that the palm tree gets its name from the shape of its leaves, which look like the fingers of a hand? So, the palm fronds that we wave are related to the palms of our hands. And, in many traditional depictions of the crucifixion, Jesus is shown with nails through the palms of his hands (whether historically accurate or not). Which leads us to this consideration on the word palm: How many times in our words and actions do we wave our palm branches and shout "Hosanna" by walking in the way of the Lord, and how many times through our sinfulness do we shout "Crucify him" and drive nails into the palms of our Savior? How often do we extend our palms in friendship and welcome, and how often do we enclose them in fists of selfishness and exclusion? As we begin this Holy Week it is good to know that a helpful way to prepare is, literally, in our hands.

La liturgia del Domingo de Ramos es un caso de contrastes. Tenemos la procesión de entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén al principio con la multitud agitando ramas de palma y gritando "Hosanna", luego su dolorosa procesión hacia su muerte en el Gólgota con la multitud gritando "¡Crucifícalo!" Una forma interesante de reflexionar sobre esto es a través de la palabra "palma". ¿Sabías que la palmera recibe su nombre por la forma de sus hojas, que parecen los dedos de una mano? Entonces, las hojas de palma que ondeamos están relacionadas con las palmas de nuestras manos. Y, en muchas representaciones tradicionales de la crucifixión, se muestra a Jesús con clavos a través de las palmas de sus manos (ya sea históricamente exacto o no). Lo que nos lleva a esta consideración en la palabra palma: cuántas veces en nuestras palabras y acciones agitamos nuestras ramas de palma y gritamos "Hosanna" caminando en el camino del Señor, y cuántas veces a través de nuestra pecaminosidad gritamos "Crucifícalo" y clavamos clavos en las palmas de nuestro Salvador. ¿Con qué frecuencia extendemos nuestras palmas en señal de amistad y bienvenida, y con qué frecuencia las encerramos en puños de egoísmo y exclusión? Al comenzar esta Semana Santa, es bueno saber que una manera útil de prepararnos está, literalmente, en nuestras manos.
