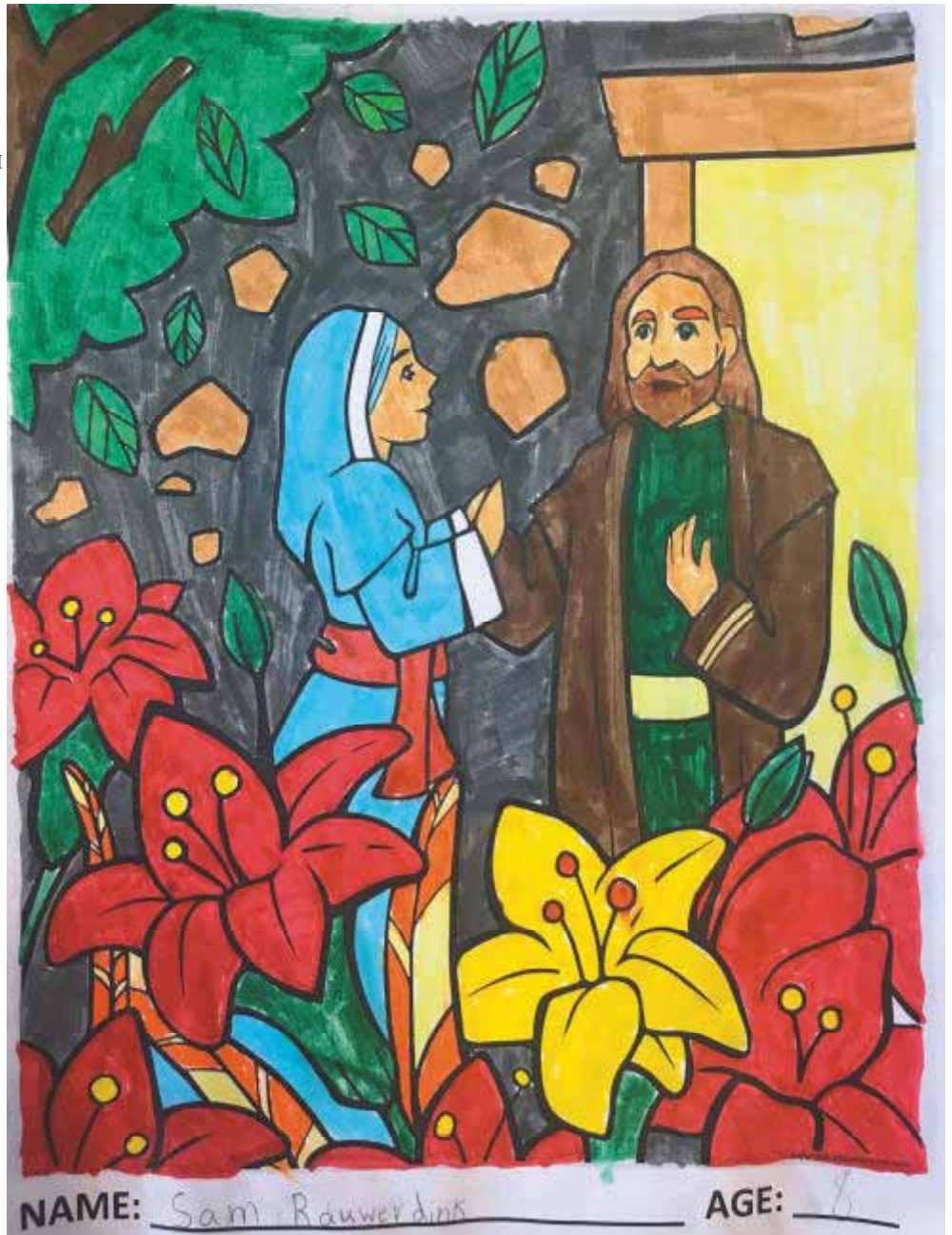

Gospel Reflection By

A sigh of relief? And what Ferris Bueller has to say about it.

Whew. A sigh of relief. For forty days we built up to the days of the Triduum with fasting, alms and prayer. Then we had the rush of Holy Week, the institution of the Eucharist on Thursday, the passion and death on Friday, the celebration of the Vigil on Saturday, and the glorious resurrection on Sunday. It was an incredible spiritual experience and at the same time perhaps emotionally exhausting. It's only natural that we sigh with relief – Jesus has risen! In many ways, it feels like Easter Sunday was an ending, a culmination.

But... this is where Ferris comes in. The movie *Ferris Bueller's Day Off* is often regarded as popularizing the concept of "breaking the fourth wall." In breaking the fourth wall, the actor speaks directly to the audience. Today Jesus breaks the fourth wall way before Ferris Bueller ever did. He is speaking to his apostles and tells them "it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem." In the very last line in our reading from Luke, Jesus says "You are witnesses of these things." I believe Jesus was not just speaking to the apostles here, but to us as well. If this scene was in a movie, I could see him turn away from the apostles and face the camera, and us, to deliver this last line.

So, yes, Jesus is risen! Alleluia! But the movie isn't over. Or perhaps, the first movie is over, but now is time for that sequel – and we are the actors; we are the witnesses. We know what our role is, let's now go and play our parts.

¿Un suspiro de alivio? Y que tiene que decir Ferris Bueller al respecto.

Uf. Un suspiro de alivio. Durante cuarenta días construimos hasta los días del Triduo con ayuno, limosna y oración. Luego tuvimos la fiebre de la Semana Santa, la institución de la Eucaristía el jueves, la pasión y muerte el viernes, la celebración de la Vigilia el sábado y la gloriosa resurrección el domingo. Fue una experiencia espiritual increíble y, al mismo tiempo, quizás emocionalmente agotadora. Es natural que suspiramos de alivio: ¡Jesús ha resucitado! En muchos sentidos, parece que el Domingo de Pascua fue un final, una culminación.

Pero... aquí es donde entra en juego Ferris. A menudo se considera que la película *Ferris Bueller's Day Off* populariza el concepto de "romper la cuarta pared". Al romper la cuarta pared, el actor habla directamente a la audiencia. Hoy Jesús rompe la cuarta pared mucho antes que Ferris Bueller. Él está hablando a sus apóstoles y les dice "está escrito que el Cristo sufriría y resucitaría de los muertos al tercer día y que el arrepentimiento, para el perdón de los pecados, se predicaría en su nombre a todas las naciones, comenzando desde Jerusalén". En la última línea de nuestra lectura de San Lucas, Jesús dice: "Vosotros sois testigos de estas cosas". Creo que Jesús no solo les estaba hablando a los apóstoles aquí, sino también a nosotros. Si esta escena fuera en una película, podría verlo alejarse de los apóstoles y mirar a la cámara, y a nosotros, para entregar esta última línea.

Entonces, sí, ¡Jesús ha resucitado! ¡Aleluya! Pero la película no ha terminado. O tal vez, la primera película terminó, pero ahora es el momento de esa secuela, y nosotros somos los actores; somos los testigos. Sabemos cuál es nuestro papel, vayamos ahora y hagamos nuestro papel.
