Divine Mercy Sunday, The Second Sunday of Easter

Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter. The scriptural readings, homily, and liturgical prayers that day are all centered on the forgiveness of sins and God's infinite mercy, which endures forever. Pope St. John Paul II in 2000 at his public announcement during the homily for St. Faustina's canonization, stated: "It is important then that we accept the whole message that comes to us from the word of God on this Second Sunday of Easter, *which from now on throughout the Church will be called 'Divine Mercy Sunday.'*"

The image of Divine Mercy displayed in our Sanctuary today and in our Prayer Chapel all other days portrays the Risen Jesus Christ bringing Mercy to the whole world. In a private apparition Our Lord said to St. Faustina: "**I want the image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it. I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish**" (Diary 341, 48). Jesus also told her that this Feast of Mercy would be a very special day when "**all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened**" (Diary 699). Please take time to visit with our Image of The Divine Mercy and thank Jesus for His mercy.

The Divine Mercy devotion also includes a plenary indulgence and the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. Jesus promised that "**The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment**" (Diary 699). He went on to say "**I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy**" (Diary 1109). Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, Segundo Domingo de Pascua

El Domingo de la Divina Misericordia se celebra el Segundo Domingo de Pascua. Las lecturas de las Escrituras, la homilía y las oraciones litúrgicas de ese día se centran en el perdón de los pecados y la misericordia infinita de Dios, que perdura para siempre.

El Papa San Juan Pablo II en 2000 en su anuncio público durante la homilía de canonización de Santa Faustina, declaró: "Es importante entonces que aceptemos todo el mensaje que nos llega de la palabra de Dios en este Segundo Domingo de Pascua, *que de ahora en adelante en toda la Iglesia se llamará 'Domingo de la Divina Misericordia'.*"

La imagen de la Divina Misericordia que se exhibe en nuestro Santuario hoy y en nuestra Capilla de Oración todos los demás días representa a Jesucristo Resucitado trayendo Misericordia a todo el mundo. En una aparición privada, Nuestro Señor le dijo a Santa Faustina: "**Quiero que la imagen sea bendecida solemnemente el primer domingo después de Pascua, y quiero que sea venerada públicamente para que todas las almas la conozcan. Prometo que el alma que venere esta imagen no perecerá**" (Diario 341, 48). Jesús también le dijo que esta Fiesta de la Misericordia sería un día muy especial cuando "**todas las compuertas divinas por las que fluyen las gracias**" (Diario 699). Tómese el tiempo para visitar nuestra Imagen de la Divina Misericordia y agradecer a Jesús por Su misericordia.

La devoción a la Divina Misericordia también incluye una indulgencia plenaria y la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia. Jesús prometió que "**El alma que se confesará y recibirá la Sagrada Comunión obtendrá el perdón total de los pecados y el castigo**" (Diario 699). Continuó diciendo "**Quiero conceder un perdón total a las almas que se confesarán y recibirán la Sagrada Comunión en la Fiesta de Mi Misericordia**" (Diario 1109). Gospel Reflection By Dcn. Jerome Buhman

The Bible is full of mysteries, some more famous than others. What happened to the Ark of the Covenant? Where did Moses cross the Red Sea? Or was it the Reed Sea? And what did Jonah smell like after three days in the belly of a giant fish?

One of the things that has puzzled me over the years makes an appearance in today's Gospel. We hear from Thomas, who is called Didymus, which means "the Twin." Thomas was a twin – so who was Thomas' twin? Thomas' twin never shows up in the New Testament.

Well, after diligent searching, I believe I have found the twin.

We are Thomas' twins. When we look in the mirror, we see Thomas. Who amongst us hasn't doubted? We live in an age of doubt. Advances in technology and the spread of social media have increased our level of doubt instead of lessening it. Remember the old saying, "a picture never lies?" That certainly is not true anymore, if it ever was. Doubt seems to be our constant companion, and it even seems we cannot rely even on our senses as Thomas did.

But Jesus told Thomas "Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." Because seeing and doubting are both products of our mind. Belief is not. Belief is a product of the heart. You can reason toward belief, but to actually believe takes an act of will. It's right there in the word itself – the ancient core word that is at the root of our word "believe" means "to care, to love." Belief is rooted in love. And it is belief rooted in love which makes us cry out with Thomas: "My Lord and my God."

La Biblia está llena de misterios, algunos más famosos que otros. ¿Qué pasó con el Arca de la Alianza? ¿Dónde cruzó Moisés el Mar Rojo? ¿O fue el Mar de los juncos? ¿Y a qué olía Jonás después de tres días en el vientre de un pez gigante?

Una de las cosas que me ha desconcertado a lo largo de los años aparece en el Evangelio de hoy. Escuchamos a Tomás, conocido como Dídimos, que significa "el gemelo". Tomás era un gemelo, entonces, ¿quién era el gemelo de Tomás? El gemelo de Tomás nunca aparece en el Nuevo Testamento. Bueno, después de una búsqueda diligente, creo que he encontrado al gemelo.

Somos los gemelos de Tomás. Cuando nos miramos al espejo, vemos a Tomás. ¿Quién de nosotros no ha dudado? Vivimos en una época de dudas. Los avances en la tecnología y la difusión de las redes sociales han aumentado nuestro nivel de duda en lugar de disminuirlo. ¿Recuerda el viejo dicho, "una imagen nunca miente"? Eso ciertamente ya no es cierto, si es que alguna vez lo fue. La duda parece ser nuestra compañera constante, e incluso parece que no podemos confiar ni siquiera en nuestros sentidos como lo hizo Tomás.

Pero Jesús le dijo a Tomás: "Bienaventurados los que no vieron y creyeron". Porque ver y dudar son ambos productos de nuestra mente. La creencia no lo es. La fe es producto del corazón. Puedes razonar hacia la creencia, pero creer realmente requiere un acto de voluntad. Está ahí mismo, en la palabra misma: la antigua palabra central que está en la raíz de nuestra palabra "creer" significa "cuidar, amar". La fe tiene sus raíces en el amor. Y es la fe arraigada en el amor lo que nos hace gritar con Tomás: "Señor mío y Dios mío".

The Plenary Indulgence (complete forgiveness of sins and punishment due to sin)

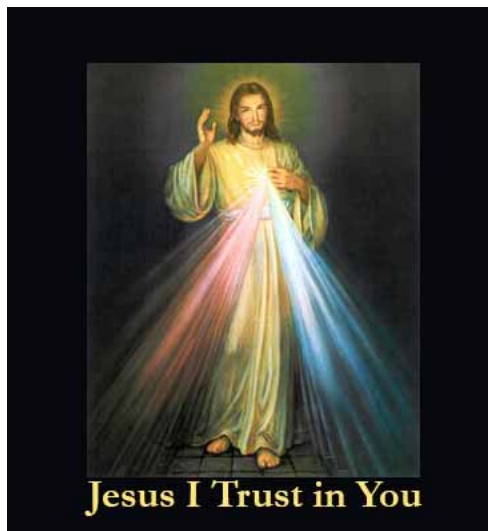
This Sunday, April 11, is Divine Mercy Sunday. Jesus told St. Faustina in a private apparition that this Feast of Mercy would be a very special day when “all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened” (Diary 699). Jesus promised that “The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment” (Diary 699). He went on to say “I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy” (Diary 1109).

This plenary indulgence (the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment due to sin) is granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff) to the faithful who, on the Second Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!). It is allowed for one to go to Confession up to about 20 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday to receive this plenary indulgence.

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy

In 1935 St. Faustina Kowalska was inspired by God to pray the prayer that is now known as the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. It is especially appropriate after receiving Holy Communion. Jesus specifically told St. Faustina to pray it during the nine days before Divine Mercy Sunday. It is also very appropriate to pray the Chaplet at 3 PM in the afternoon.

A description of how to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy is on the back of this page.

How To Pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy on Rosary Beads

Optional Opening Prayers:

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world.

O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

(Repeat 3 times) O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

Our Father, Hail Mary and the Apostle's Creed

For each of the five decades *(On each "Our Father" bead of the rosary, pray)*

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

(On each of the 10 "Hail Mary" beads, pray)

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Concluding prayer *(Repeat 3 times)*

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Optional Closing Prayer

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.
