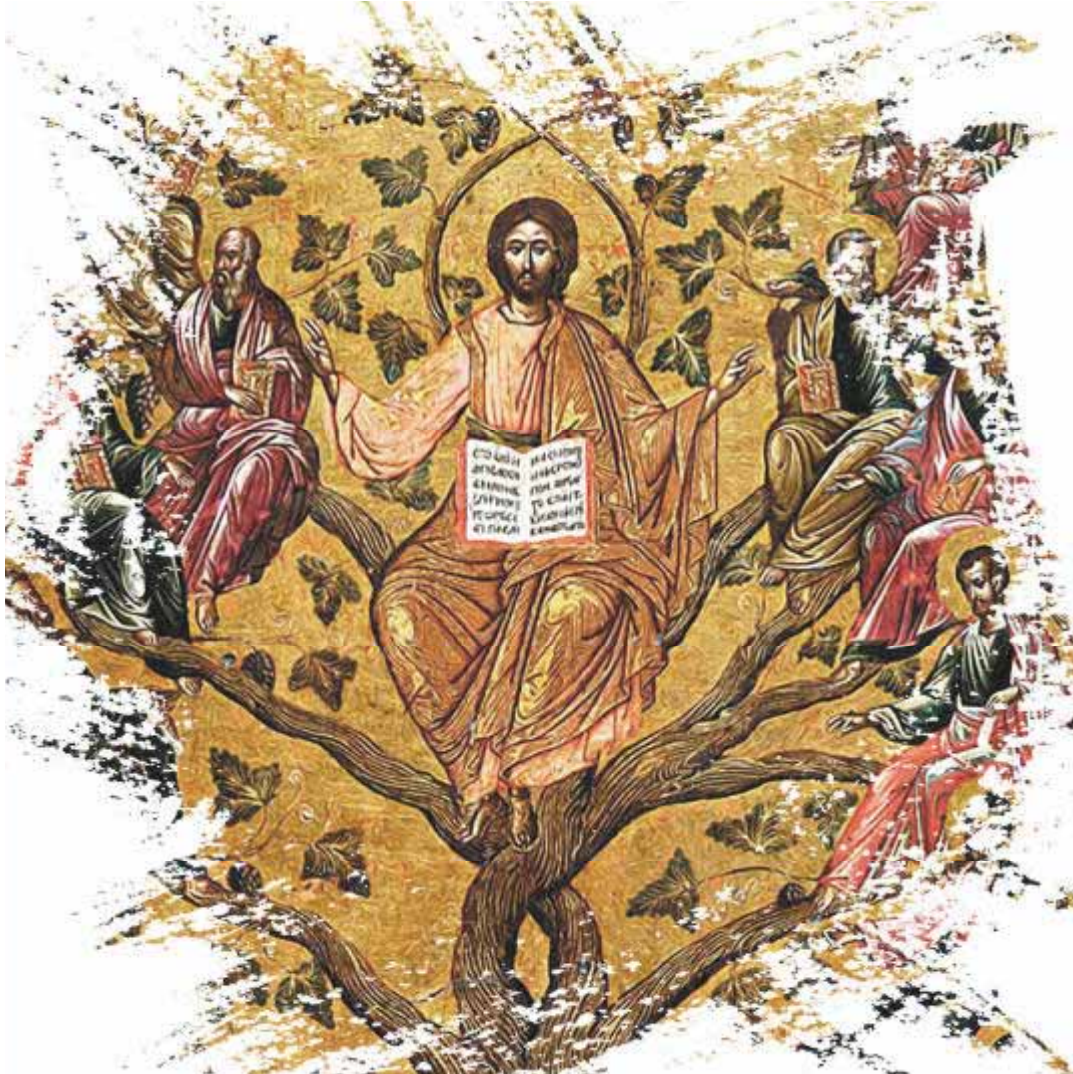

May- The Month of Mary

Today we will celebrate May Crowning after the 6:30 PM and 10:00 AM Masses. May is the Month of Mary and May Crowning is a traditional Catholic devotion expressing love and honor for our Blessed Mother through Marian hymns, prayers, and flowers. Emeritus Pope Benedict XVI, in his weekly address on April 30, 2006, explained Mary's month:

In the days that followed the Lord's Resurrection, the Apostles stayed together, comforted by Mary's presence, and after the Ascension they persevered with her in prayerful expectation of Pentecost. Our Lady was a mother and teacher to them, a role that she continues to play for Christians of all times. Every year, at Eastertide, we relive this experience more intensely and perhaps, precisely for this reason, popular tradition has dedicated to Mary the month of May that normally falls between Easter and Pentecost. Consequently, this month which we begin tomorrow helps us to rediscover the maternal role that she plays in our lives so that we may always be docile disciples and courageous witnesses of the Risen Lord. Let us entrust to Mary the needs of the Church and of the whole world.

We pray through Mary's intercession for an end of the pandemic and healing for the whole world.

COVID-19 Protocols

I am inspired by the care you have showed one another during the pandemic. I appreciate your communication regarding Mass attendance, help sanitizing the pews, willingness to wear a mask and social distance, and help with ushering and hospitality.

New guidelines by the CDC and Diocese now allow us to make adjustments. Only a few trained people will sanitize the pews and use fewer chemicals. We can have Altar Servers again and process into and out of Church. I hope that eventually we no longer have to wear masks or block off the pews, but until then, I ask for your patience and thoughtfulness towards others. Sometimes, seating in the church proper may be unavailable and you may be asked to sit in the Social Hall or the Gathering Area. Patience, like all virtues, comes with practice. If these limitations and temporary requirements are a burden, they are also sufferings we can endure and offer up for the salvation of souls, our own included.

As we begin the Month of Mary Our Mother, I strongly encourage us, with Mary's motherly promptings, to return in person to the Altar of our Church where we receive the Body and Blood of Christ as the true food of eternal life. At the same time, we have committed to continue live-streaming for those who are vulnerable and cannot be with us. Please contact the Parish Office if you would like to receive Holy Communion (833-2600).

There is hope! As immunity increases and infections decrease, I pray that we can return better than normal in all we do as a parish family. I thank everyone for your faithfulness, cooperation, and generosity during this difficult and confusing time. I look forward to the future, trusting that we all may be one in our commitment to remain faithful to the Lord and supportive of each other.

Mayo: El mes de María

Hoy celebraremos la Coronación de Mayo después de las Misas de 6:30 PM y de las 10:00 AM Mayo es el Mes de María y la Coronación de Mayo es una devoción católica tradicional que expresa amor y honor por nuestra Santísima Madre a través de himnos marianos, oraciones y flores. El Papa emérito Benedicto XVI, en su discurso semanal del 30 de abril de 2006, explicó el mes de María:

En los días que siguieron a la Resurrección del Señor, los Apóstoles permanecieron juntos, consolados por la presencia de María, y después de la Ascensión perseveraron con ella en la espera orante de Pentecostés. Nuestra Señora fue madre y maestra para ellos, un papel que sigue desempeñando para los cristianos de todos los tiempos. Cada año, en Semana Santa, revivimos esta experiencia con más intensidad y quizás, precisamente por eso, la tradición popular ha dedicado a María el mes de mayo que normalmente se sitúa entre Pascua y Pentecostés. En consecuencia, este mes que comenzamos mañana nos ayuda a redescubrir el papel maternal que ella juega en nuestra vida para que seamos siempre discípulos dóciles y testigos valientes del Señor Resucitado. Recomendemos a María las necesidades de la Iglesia y del mundo entero.

Oramos por la intercesión de María para el fin de la pandemia y la sanación del mundo entero.

Protocolos del COVID-19

Estoy conmovido con el cuidado que se han mostrado unos a otros durante la pandemia. Agradezco su comunicación con respecto a la asistencia a Misa, la ayuda para desinfectar los bancos, la disposición a usar una mascarilla y mantener la distancia física y la ayuda con la disposición del espacio y la hospitalidad.

Las nuevas pautas de los Centros para el control y la prevención de enfermedades (CDC, por sus siglas en inglés) y la Diócesis ahora nos permiten hacer ajustes. Solo unas pocas personas capacitadas desinfectarán los bancos y usarán menos productos químicos. Podemos tener monaguillos nuevamente y procesar dentro y fuera de la Iglesia. Espero que eventualmente ya no tengamos que usar mascarillas ni bloquear las bancas, pero hasta entonces, les pido paciencia y consideración hacia los demás. A veces, es posible que no haya asientos disponibles en la iglesia propiamente dicha y es posible que se le pida que se sienten en el salón de convivio o en el área de recepción. La paciencia, como todas las virtudes, viene con la práctica. Si estas limitaciones y requisitos temporales son una carga, también son sufrimientos que podemos soportar y ofrecer por la salvación de las almas, incluyendo la nuestra.

Al comenzar el Mes de María Nuestra Madre, con la inspiración maternal de María, los exhorto encarecidamente a regresar en persona al Altar de nuestra Iglesia donde recibimos el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo como el verdadero alimento de la vida eterna. Al mismo tiempo, nos hemos comprometido a continuar la transmisión en vivo para aquellos que son vulnerables y no pueden estar con nosotros. Comuníquense con la Oficina Parroquial si desean recibir la Sagrada Comunión (608) 833-2600.

¡Hay esperanza! A medida que aumenta la inmunidad y disminuyen las infecciones, oro para que podamos regresar mucho mejor que lo normal en todo lo que hacemos como familia parroquial. Agradezco a todos por su fidelidad, cooperación y generosidad durante este momento difícil y confuso. Miro hacia el futuro, confiando en que todos seamos uno en nuestro compromiso de permanecer fieles al Señor y apoyarnos unos a otros.

Gospel Reflection By

“Remain in me, as I remain in you.” This phrase struck me as I read the Gospel for the 5th Sunday of Easter and rattled around in my head for a couple of days. Since it wouldn’t leave me alone, I looked up the passage in my Complete Parallel Bible, which puts four Bible translations side by side. Two translations were the same as our Gospel reading, another said “Abide in me, as I abide in you,” and another said “Dwell in me, as I in you.” If taken all together, I think one common aspect of all these words in context is “live,” as in “Live in me as I live in you.” I think it is important to note this more active element of the term used. Christ’s presence is not a passive one, but rather one that calls us to action. If his word is in us, we must live as though it is. Hearing is not enough, knowing is not enough -- we must live the Word that dwells within us – that is the way to bear fruit.

Reflexión del Evangelio

“Permanezcan en mí, como yo permanezco en ti”. Esta frase me llamó la atención mientras leía el Evangelio para el quinto domingo de Pascua y me dio vueltas en la cabeza durante un par de días. Como no me dejaba en paz, busqué el pasaje en mi Biblia paralela completa, que pone cuatro traducciones de la Biblia una al lado de la otra. Dos traducciones eran iguales a nuestra lectura del Evangelio, otra decía “Vivan en mí, como yo vivo en vosotros”, y otra decía “Morad en mí, como yo en vosotros”. Si se toman en conjunto, creo que un aspecto común de todas estas palabras en contexto es “vivir”, como en “Vivan en mí como yo vivo en ustedes”. Creo que es importante señalar este elemento más activo del término utilizado. La presencia de Cristo no es pasiva, sino que nos llama a la acción. Si su palabra está en nosotros, debemos vivir como si lo estuviera. Escuchar no es suficiente, conocer no es suficiente, debemos vivir la Palabra que habita en nosotros, esa es la manera de dar fruto.
