Happy Father's Day during this Year of St. Joseph!

We wish all of our fathers and those who have been like fathers to us, a very blessed and happy Father's Day! We are grateful to the men of our parish who have sacrificed so much for their families and for our parish family. Thank you to our fathers, living and deceased, for your love, support, and example of faith.

Pope Francis has made this year a special year dedicated to St. Joseph. St. Joseph is the patron saint of fathers, and the ideal saint to feature for Father's Day. As the step-father of Jesus, the Messiah, and the husband of Mary, the Blessed Mother, Joseph stands out as the father above all other fathers in the New Testament. It was an indescribable honor for him to stand in for God the Father to bring up the Son of God. In order to respond to such a high calling, Joseph lived an exemplary life, and set the standard for every father who came after him. Fathers who want to live their vocation well should take their cues from Joseph.

Let us reflect on some of the qualities of St. Joseph we can emulate, especially that our fathers can emulate as they live out their vocation:

1. St. Joseph was a beloved, tender, obedient father. He was obedient to God's will over his will. Even when we are confused or facing the unknown, St. Joseph shows us to remain faithful and obedient to God's will.
2. St. Joseph had a deep love for Mary and for Jesus. We too want to deepen our love for Jesus and Mary.
3. St. Joseph was an accepting father. We see this in how he accepted Mary unconditionally, even though he did not understand how she was pregnant. St. Joseph encourages us to accept and welcome others as they are, without exception, and to show special concern for the weak.
4. St. Joseph is courageously creative. We see this in his flight into Egypt with the Holy Family to avoid King Herod and his efforts to kill Jesus. When facing real concrete problems, they trusted in God and did what was difficult but necessary to survive and eventually were able to return home safely.
5. St. Joseph teaches us the dignity and value and joy of work. He worked as a carpenter to provide for the family. He put his God-given talents to work at the service of society.

Pope Francis has asked us in a special way this year to pray to St. Joseph. He can be a great help to all of us and especially to all fathers.

Como padrastro de Jesús, el Mesías y esposo de María, la Santísima Madre, José se destaca como el padre por encima de todos los demás padres en el Nuevo Testamento. Fue un honor indescribible para él reemplazar a Dios el Padre para criar al Hijo de Dios. Para responder a un llamado tan elevado, José vivió una vida ejemplar y estableció el estándar para cada padre que vino después de él. Los padres que quieren vivir bien su vocación deben seguir los rasgos de José.

Reflexionemos sobre algunas de las cualidades de San José que podemos emular, especialmente las que nuestros padres pueden emular mientras viven su vocación:

1. San José fue un padre amado, tierno y obediente. Fue obediente a la voluntad de Dios sobre su voluntad. Incluso cuando estamos confundidos o enfrentamos lo desconocido, San José nos muestra que debemos permanecer fieles y obedientes a la voluntad de Dios.
2. San José tenía un profundo amor por María y por Jesús. También nosotros queremos profundizar nuestro amor por Jesús y María.
3. San José fue un padre que acepta. Vemos esto en cómo aceptó incondicionalmente a María, aunque no entendió cómo estaba embarazada. San José nos anima a aceptar y acoger a los demás tal como son, sin excepción, ya mostrar especial preocupación por los débiles.
4. San José es valientemente creativo. Vemos esto en su huida a Egipto con la Sagrada Familia para evitar al rey Herodes y sus esfuerzos por matar a Jesús. Al enfrentarse a problemas reales y concretos, confiaron en Dios e hicieron lo que era difícil pero necesario para sobrevivir y finalmente pudieron regresar a casa sanos y salvos.
5. San José nos enseña la dignidad, el valor y la alegría del trabajo. Trabajó como carpintero para proporcionar lo necesario a la familia. Puso sus talentos dados por Dios a trabajar en el servicio de la sociedad.

El Papa Francisco nos ha pedido de manera especial este año que recemos a San José. Puede ser de gran ayuda para todos nosotros y especialmente a todos los padres.

Microlending Program

Is your family facing an unexpected expense such as a needed car repair or a medical bill? Are you making large monthly payments to a payday lender? Does your home have a plumbing or electrical problem but you lack the funds to pay for its repair?

As the result of a donation from a generous parishioner, the St. Thomas Aquinas Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul is beginning a micro-lending program. It will consider lending up to \$1000 to individuals who have the types of needs described above.

Loan recipients must have a regular source of income. They must be members of St. Thomas Aquinas Parish or live within zip codes 53705 or 53717. Loans will not be made to pay overdue rent or utility bills.

No interest will be charged for these loans. Loans are for a term of one year.

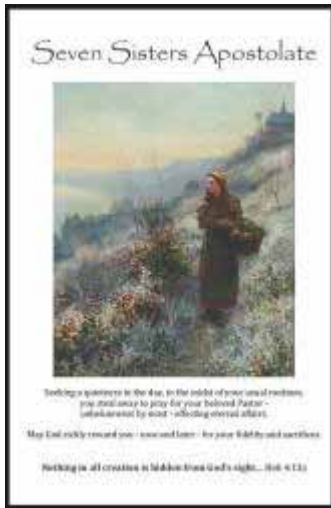

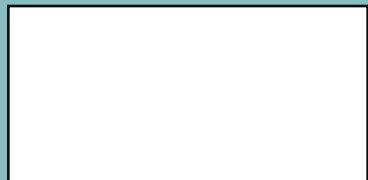

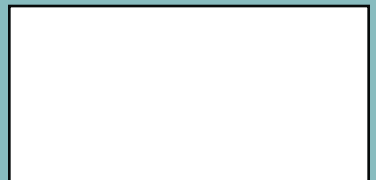
