### Stations of the Cross: A Lenten Walk with Jesus

The Stations of the Cross is a visual representation of Jesus' suffering from the time when Pontius Pilate condemned him to death until the moment when he was put in the grave. The Stations of the Cross are, above all, a prayer we pray when we remember Jesus' suffering. The St. Thomas Aquinas Stations of the Cross are located on the inner side walls of the main church. Stations of the Cross booklets will be available in the Gathering Area if you would like to pray the Stations of the Cross on your own.

On **Fridays** during Lent, we will pray the Stations of the Cross at **6:00 PM**, complete with music, followed by a simple supper of soup and bread. Each week, as we eat, we'll hear someone speak briefly about their experience of faith, and how Jesus has been part of their journey. This is a great opportunity to invite friends and neighbors to join us as we experience the great love of Jesus.
